




**BACKGROUND:**

Assembly Bill 694 seeks to amend Article 5 of the California Veterans Code, commencing with Section 998.700 to Chapter 6 of Division 4, relating to Veterans Housing by providing funds necessary. Therefore, through an election for the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and for the handling and disposition of those funds. This bill would permit the issuance of \$600,000,000 in additional funding for the Veterans Housing and Homeless Prevention Act of 2014. The bill would provide submission of the bond act to voters at the March 3, 2020 primary election. Given our present shortage of affordable housing for our veterans and their families support for Assembly Bill 694 is one more step in securing funds for such a worthy cause.
