

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA



On motion of Supervisor Spiegel, seconded by Supervisor Jeffries, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, June 18, 2019 be adjourned in memory of John Malloch "Terry" Mylne III, a beloved 86-year-old resident of Laguna Niguel, California who passed away on May 25, 2019.

Born on May 1, 1933 in Los Angeles, California, Terry was a lifelong resident of Riverside, California. He attended Palm Elementary, Central Junior High, and Riverside Poly High School. He then spent two years at Kenyon College in Ohio, before signing up with the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War. Following his military service, Terry attended Stanford University, earning both a BS in Electrical Engineering and an MBA. While at Stanford, he met Bonnie Jane Russell and they were married on February 10, 1962.

Terry worked as a Manger of Fluid Systems at Wyle Labs and later as Director of Engineering at The Toro Company. He holds a number of patents for the electrical controllers and sprinkler systems that he developed.

Active in the community, Terry served as Director of the Western Municipal Water District from 1978 to 1995 and then as a Director on the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board of Directors from 1993 to 2008. He served as President of the World Affairs Council of Inland Southern California, President of the Riverside Arts Foundation, and was a member of the UCR Chancellors Advisory Council for both the School of Engineering and the School of Agriculture. He was also a longtime member of the Victoria Club, Kiwanis Club of Riverside, and Men's Breakfast Forum. He enjoyed golfing, snow skiing, sailing, and working on his family home, Greystones.

Terry was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend. He is survived by his wife BJ; three children, Bonnie Small (Anthony), Victoria Grovier (Sean), and John Mylne IV (Kristina); six grandchildren, Meghan, Kyle, Thomas, Samantha, Ian, and Gwendolyn; and his sister Helen Timmons.

Terry's memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be greatly missed but never forgotten.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.


