BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Board of Supervisors adopted Riverside County Ordinance No. 525.5 effective April 16, 1998. Section 2 of the Ordinance established a five (5) member Board of Examiners, appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The members are appointed for three (3) year terms, not to exceed a collective appointment of ten (10) years.

The Ordinance specifies that the Board members are from certain occupations. Jared Calsing and Max Mendoza are two representatives from the domestic water supply industry. Roland Hazzard is a member of the plumbing industry. Derrick Spencer and Christina Quintero are two representatives from the Department of Environmental Health.

The Board of Examiners meets quarterly to test and certify individuals to inspect backflow assemblies throughout the County of Riverside.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Additional Fiscal Information

The recommended action will have no additional fiscal impact to the Department. The expenses of the committee are covered through certification fees, volunteer examiners, donated equipment and other Department revenue.
