



**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Jurupa Unified School District – Parent Involvement will be used to expand their services to the Mira Loma Area by opening a Family Resource Center on the campus of Sky Country Elementary School. This center will provide many resources to families, including mental health services.
2. The donation to VFW Post 10267 will be used to improve the facility by refurbishing the floors, bathrooms, kitchen and landscaping. The facility is used by the community, veterans groups, and local elected who host workshops for veterans.
3. The donation to the Jurupa District Lions Club will be used to help improve the facility by installing new flooring, which has become dilapidated and unsafe.
4. The donation to the 100 Mile Club will provide sponsorship for elementary students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> District to participate in the programs offered by the 100 Mile Club.
5. The donation to the Country Village Senior Citizens Club will be used to sponsor their annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade and community festivities.
