BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Queen of Hearts Therapeutic Riding Center will be used provide therapeutic riding lessons to folks who are unable to pay. This would include special needs children and veterans.
2. The donation to the JUSD Charitable Purpose Foundation will be used to support the JUSD Holiday Food Drive which provides meals for needy families during the holidays.
