

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The purpose of the EMPG program is to support comprehensive emergency management at the State, Tribal and local levels and to encourage the improvement of mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery capabilities for all hazards incidents. Riverside County, functioning as the Operational Area (OA), applies for the EMPG each year and sub-grants to cities within the County. The amount applied for will be pre-determined by CalOES through a funding formula which considers both a base and the county population. As the lead agency for the OA, EMD is applying for EMPG funding on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area. These grant funds will be utilized to enhance emergency management and community preparedness. A new Signature Authority Resolution is required with each year's application. EMD will return to the Board of Supervisors for acceptance of the grant once awarded.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

EMPG funds are used to sustain capabilities for the county-wide Emergency Management Program. EMD participates in many of the citizen/business groups and provides emergency management training and information. One such training is the CERT program, which teaches residents to be self-sustaining during a catastrophic incident. These trainings are offered on a regular basis and throughout the county.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The EMPG grant is a federally funded dollar-for-dollar local cash or in-kind match. Each agency that is awarded funding is responsible for providing the dollar-for-dollar cash or in-kind match requirement. The dollar-for-dollar match portion of funding dedicated to the EMD will be derived from Emergency Services Coordinators' regular salaries that come from Net County Cost, as budgeted in the FY19/20 approved budget.

The OA uses the same type of formula as the state in order to pass funding through to participating cities and the OA accordingly. All cities are invited to participate in this grant program. The match for this pass-through amount will come from 100% City funds.

The attached resolution has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside (the "County") annually applies for and has  
9 received grant funding in past fiscal years through the Emergency Management Performance  
10 Grant (EMPG), as made available through and administered by the California Governor's  
11 Office of Emergency Services (hereinafter referred to as "Cal OES"); and

12 WHEREAS, the County desires to continue to apply for the EMPG for fiscal year 2019.

13 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of  
14 Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on July  
15 2, 2019, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located on the first floor of  
16 the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, hereby  
17 authorizes that the individuals identified below to execute for and on behalf of the County of  
18 Riverside, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any document,  
19 including agreements, amendments, extensions, and grant award document with the Cal OES,  
20 as approved to form by County Counsel and provided that the County's contribution share has  
21 been budgeted for and approved by the Board of Supervisors, for the purpose of obtaining  
22 federal financial assistance provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency and sub-  
23 granted through the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the FY19 Emergency  
24 Management Performance Grant.

26 grant period, as stipulated in the award letter and including any extensions thereof.


