



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The City of Cathedral City has complied with this requirement and has requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct its election. The department has the resources to provide these services. The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Registered voters in the City of Cathedral City will have the opportunity to vote for a City Council member in City Council District 1.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election. Approximately \$11,800 of election costs will be reimbursed by the City of Cathedral City.
