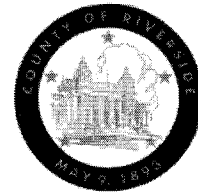



**BACKGROUND:**

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that more than 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official, is responsible for appointing WDB members for two year terms.

Ms. Sonia Nuñez, Human Resources Manager for McLane Foodservice, joined the organization in 2001 and has served in this capacity over the last 18 years including

supporting the Phoenix, Tracy and Portland locations. She has over 25 years of experience in human resources, she holds a Masters of Arts degree in Human Resources and Organizational Development, and a certification as a Senior Human Resources Professional (SPHR). In her current role, Ms. Nuñez's serves as a strategic business partner with operations and supports the company's human resources needs. She is actively involved with various human resource associations and the local HR community, and she continues to network with her peers through the HR Networking Group, Society of Human Resources Professionals and Women's Foodservice Forum. Ms. Nuñez has also been a member of the WDB for the last 6 years. She brings to light and helps address the needs of the Logistics industry, one of the five in demand industries identified by the WDB.

Ms. Sonia Nuñez has expressed interest in continuing to serve on the WDB as a Private Sector representative for the Fifth District. If appointed, she will serve a two-year term commencing July 30, 2019 and ending July 30, 2021.
