Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Thursday, August 8, 2019 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, and North Circle Resurfacing Project; and Village Center Drive Resurfacing Project in the Community of Idyllwild.

Ridgeview Drive	Park Lane to Village Center Drive	approx. 300 feet
North Circle Drive	Park Lane to Village Center Drive	approx. 200 feet
Village Center Drive	South Circle Drive to North Circle Drive	approx. 1/3 mile

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing of Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive and Village Center Drive consists of grinding the existing pavement surface and replacing it with new hot-mix asphalt concrete pavement.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of concrete curb, sidewalk, driveway, curb ramps and asphalt concrete dike, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive Resurfacing Project and Village Center Drive Resurfacing Project are two of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Alternate Bid Schedule: Manhole adjustments to grade (Idyllwild Water District)

The adjustment of a manholes owned by the Idyllwild Water District (IWD), are included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If IWD approves the award of their alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owner through a reimbursement agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

**Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing of the roadways and necessary safety improvements do not create additional automobile lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Park Lane and Village Center Drive, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in early fall of 2019. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$592,789 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** 3<sup>rd</sup>

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface 300 feet of Park Lane from Ridgeview Drive to North Circle Drive and approximately 0.3 miles of Village Center Drive from South Circle Drive to North Circle Drive. Park Lane is 41 feet wide with curb and gutter along the roadway, and is classified as a local road in the County of Riverside General Plan. Village Center Drive ranges from 24-32 feet wide with dike at various segments of the roadway, and is classified as a local road in the County of Riverside General Plan. Additionally, 300 feet of Ridgeview Drive from Park Lane to Village Center Drive and 200 feet of North Circle Drive from Park Lane to Village Center Drive will be resurfaced with the same treatment. The proposed project will include the following:

- Removal of roadway width and placing Hot Mixed Asphalt (HMA)
- Construction of curb ramp and asphalt concrete dike
- Reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike, sidewalk, driveway, overside drain, and curb/gutter
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Utility adjustments
- Removal/installation of traffic striping, pavement markers and reflectors, and signs

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right-of-way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is not within cell criteria areas and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

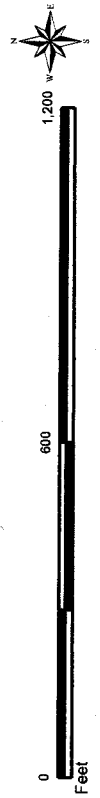
