

BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated April 30, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.35), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Ellis Avenue and Theda Street intersection widening project in the Good Hope Community of the County.

Ellis Avenue is a two-lane road that travels in the east-west direction; Theda Street is a two-lane road that travels in the north-south direction and ends at Ellis forming a T-intersection where both roads meet. The minor widening will provide a left turn pocket for westbound traffic on Ellis Avenue, turning southbound onto Theda Street.

Project construction will include placement of asphalt concrete pavement, installation of corrugated steel pipe for relocation of an existing roadside drainage ditch, reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike and driveways, removal of trees, installation and relocation of roadside signs, placement of thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, and any other work as may be required.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addendum was issued to modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The contractor, Granite Construction Company is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Ellis Avenue at Theda Street intersection widening project improves traffic flow by providing a lane for the westbound traffic turning left to move out of the flow of traffic. Ellis Avenue and Theda Street are used as routes to the Good Hope Elementary School located on the southeast corner of the intersection. The intersection widening project work will be phased to keep Ellis Avenue and Theda Street open during construction. The contractor will coordinate with the school to avoid work activities during peak hours and special events.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2019 and will take approximately five weeks to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Granite Construction Company for the total amount of \$247,742.

The project will be funded with County Service Area 41 and Gas Tax / HUTA funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Six bids were received ranging from \$247,742 to \$366,000. Four of the six received bids were higher than the Engineer's estimate. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$247,742 which is \$88,378 (26%) below the Engineer's Estimate. However, it is \$7,460 (2%) below the average cost of the six submitted bids.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, Granite Construction Company.


Vicinity Map






