

BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Riverside County Black Chamber of Commerce will be used to sponsor the Inland Empire Multi-Cultural Biz-Fest. This event creates exposure that increases opportunities to support and interact with multi-cultural businesses.
2. The donation to Bicycles for Children will be used to provide new bicycles to impoverished children. Each bicycle is delivered by a teacher to the student's home which improves the home/school connection and teacher/student bond.
