

C.E.O. RECOMMENDATION: Approve

BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

Riverside County Economic Development Agency (EDA), Workforce Development Division, applied to the California Employment Development Department for the Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program (VEAP Program). The purpose of the VEAP Program is to use sector employment strategies through industry-specific training to prepare veterans for skilled positions in high-wage, high-growth occupations. The overarching goal is to provide an effective and comprehensive delivery system that addresses the complex employment challenges facing veterans as they transition into civilian employment. Through this program, veterans will have access to a workforce initiative that recognizes the skills and life experiences they have gained from military service.

EDA was awarded \$488,635 in Governor's discretionary funds under the Workforce Innovation and Opportuning Act (WIOA) to implement the VEAP Program. Target participants include recently separated veterans, disabled veterans, campaign veterans, Gulf War-era veterans, veterans with significant barriers, and eligible spouses. During the grant term of May 1, 2019 through March 31, 2021, approximately 100 veterans are expected to be served countywide. Staff recommends approval of the attached VEAP Subgrant Agreement, which memorializes the terms of the VEAP Program grant and has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the VEAP Subgrant Agreement was reviewed and determined to be categorically exempt from CEQA under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule or "Common Sense" exemption. There is no possibility that the scope of work may have a significant effect on the environment, as the aforementioned services will have purely financial and social-welfare benefits and will not lead to any direct or reasonably indirect physical environmental impacts. A Notice of Exemption will be filed by staff with the County Clerk within 5 days of the approval of the VEAP Subgrant Agreement.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Implementing activities under the VEAP Program will strengthen linkages between the workforce and veterans services systems. In turn, processes by which veterans re-enter society and the labor force will be improved, advancing the overall goal of reducing unemployment and homelessness in the veteran population.

Additional Fiscal Information

In fiscal years 2019/20 and 2020/21 combined, there will be \$488,635 in costs, all of which will be paid for under the VEAP Subgrant Agreement with funds derived from the Governor's Discretionary WIOA funds. No budget adjustment is required. Current fiscal year cost are estimated to be \$279,220 for 12 months of program implementation, and next fiscal year cost are estimated to be \$209,415 for 9 months of program implementation.
