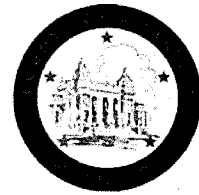



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated July 23, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.61), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive and Village Center Drive Resurfacing Projects, in the Community of Idyllwild of the County of Riverside.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing of Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive and Village Center Drive consists of grinding the existing pavement surface and replacing it with new hot-mix asphalt concrete pavement.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of concrete curb, sidewalk, driveway, curb ramps and asphalt concrete dike, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the State's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive Resurfacing Project and Village Center Drive Resurfacing Project are two of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department) recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$742,325:

Base Bid Schedule: Park Lane, Ridgeview Drive, North Circle Drive and Village Center Drive Resurfacing Projects

Alternate Bid Schedule 1: Idyllwild Water District (IWD), manholes adjustments to grade

The IWD has accepted the bid prices proposed by Hardy and Harper, Inc. for alternate bid schedule 1, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by IWD through a reimbursement agreement. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement agreements up to \$50,000 per Minute Order dated February 28, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.52).

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addenda were issued to extend the resurfacing limits of Ridgeview Drive and North Circle Drive up to State Route 243; consequently, quantities for various items of work were increased. A date of completion by October 25, 2019 requirement was also issued by addendum. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The contractor, Hardy and Harper, Inc. is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid. The contractor will execute the Contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board of Supervisor award approval.

Environmental findings: Revised Project Limits

Transportation Department extended the resurfacing limits of Ridgeview Drive and North Circle Drive up to State Route 243 by addendum, approximately 560 additional feet combined. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing of the roadways and necessary safety improvements do not create additional automobiles lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Park Lane and Village Center Drive, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in September of 2019. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately five weeks to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Hardy and Harper, Inc. for the total amount of \$742,325.

The project will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1, and Idyllwild Water District funds.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Four bids were received on Thursday, August 8, 2019 ranging from \$742,325 to \$1,234,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Hardy and Harper, Inc. in the amount of \$742,325, which is \$110,223 (17.4%) above the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Hardy and Harper, Inc.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface 300 feet of Park Lane from Ridgeview Drive to North Circle Drive and approximately 0.3 miles of Village Center Drive from South Circle Drive to North Circle Drive. Park Lane is 41 feet wide with curb and gutter along the roadway, and is classified as a local road in the County of Riverside General Plan. Village Center Drive ranges from 24-32 feet wide with dike at various segments of the roadway, and is classified as a local road in the County of Riverside General Plan. Additionally, 700 feet of Ridgeview Drive from State Highway 243 to Village Center Drive and 300 feet of North Circle Drive from State Highway 243 to Village Center Drive will be resurfaced with the same treatment. The proposed project will include the following:

- Removal of roadway width and placing Hot Mixed Asphalt (HMA)
- Construction of curb ramp and asphalt concrete dike

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right-of-way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is not within cell criteria areas and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface Park Lane, Village Center Drive and Ridgeview Drive, as well as a small segment of North Circle Drive. Additionally, the project proposes necessary safety improvements such as reconstruction of walkway, sidewalk, driveway, curb and gutter, and placement of safety edge on shoulder backing. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing of the roadways and necessary safety improvements do not create additional automobiles lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

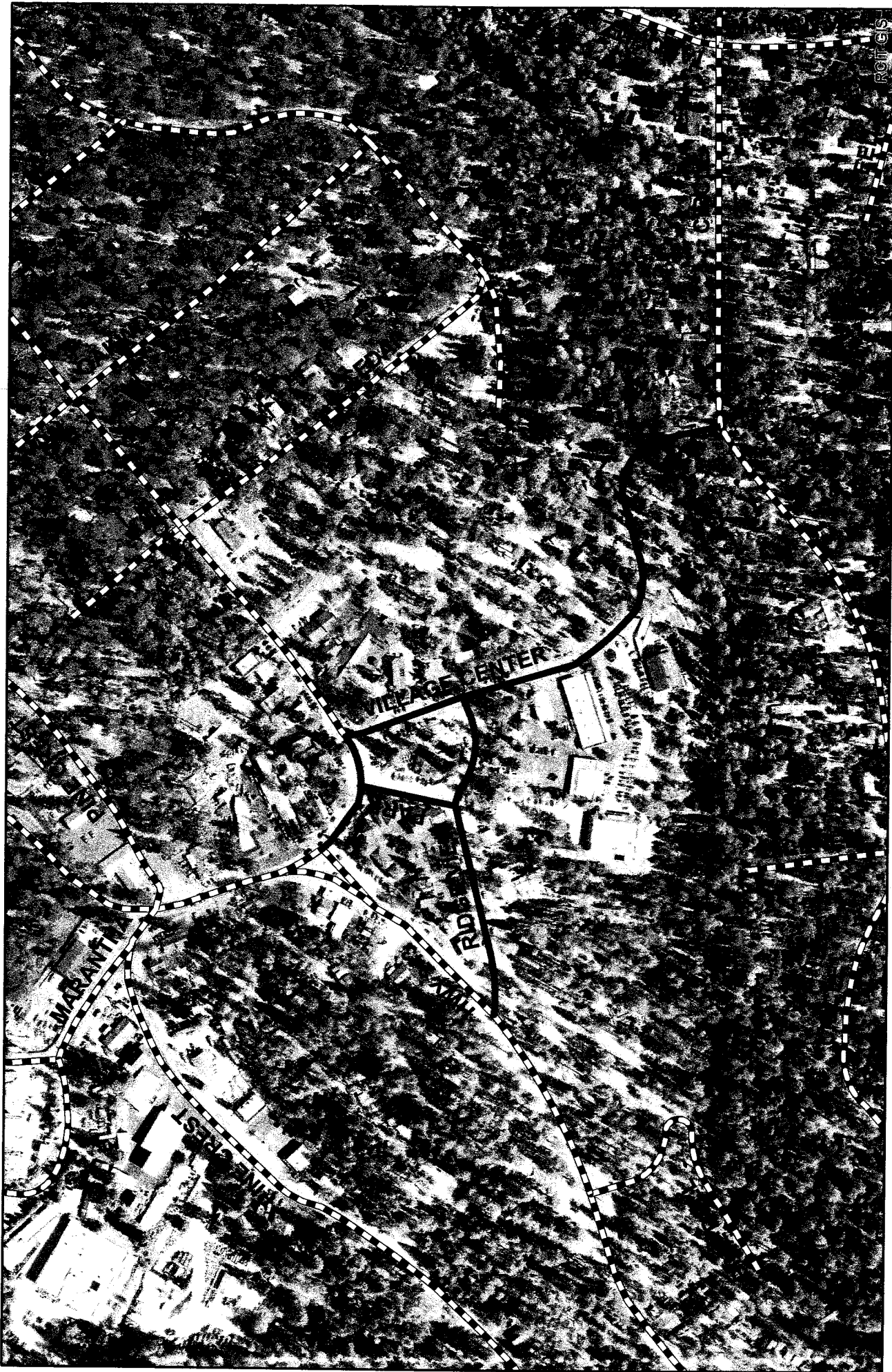

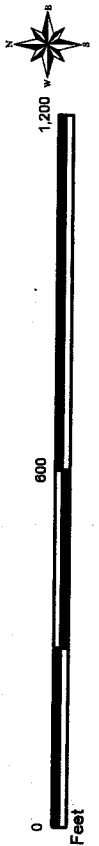



- a. A land motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer designed for travel on public roads, including any attached machinery or equipment; or
- b. Any other land vehicle that is subject to a compulsory or financial responsibility law or other motor vehicle insurance law where it is licensed or principally garaged.

However, "auto" does not include "mobile equipment".

- 5. "Bodily injury" means physical:

- a. Injury;
- b. Sickness; or
- c. Disease;

- (3) "Advertising injury" or "personal injury" offenses that take place through the Internet or similar electronic means of communication

Designated Construction Project(s): where required by written contract

Information required to complete this Schedule, if not shown above, will be shown in the Declarations.

- A. For all sums which the insured becomes legally obligated to pay as damages caused by "occurrences" under Section I – Coverage A, and for all medical expenses caused by accidents under Section I – Coverage C, which can be attributed only to ongoing operations at a single designated construction project shown in the Schedule above:
 - 1. A separate Designated Construction Project General Aggregate Limit applies to each designated construction project, and that limit is equal to the amount of the General Aggregate Limit shown in the Declarations.
 - 2. The Designated Construction Project General Aggregate Limit is the most we will pay for the sum of all damages under Coverage A, except damages because of "bodily injury" or "property damage" included in the "products-completed operations hazard", and for medical expenses under Coverage C regardless of the number of:
 - a. Insureds;
 - b. Claims made or "suits" brought; or
 - c. Persons or organizations making claims or bringing "suits".
 - 3. Any payments made under Coverage A for damages or under Coverage C for medical expenses shall reduce the Designated Construction Project General Aggregate Limit for that designated construction project. Such payments shall not reduce the General Aggregate Limit shown in the Declarations nor shall they reduce any other Designated Construction Project General Aggregate Limit for any other designated construction project shown in the Schedule above.

A. Amended Who Is An Insured

1. The following is added to the **Who Is An Insured** Provision in **Section II – Covered Autos Liability Coverage**:

The following are also "insureds":

- a. Any "employee" of yours is an "insured" while using a covered "auto" you don't own, hire or borrow for acts performed within the scope of employment by you. Any "employee" of yours is also an "insured" while operating an "auto" hired or rented under a contract or agreement in an "employee's" name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of your business.
- b. Anyone volunteering services to you is an "insured" while using a covered "auto" you don't own, hire or borrow to transport your clients or other persons in activities necessary to your business.
- c. Anyone else who furnishes an "auto" referenced in Paragraphs A.1.a. and A.1.b. in this endorsement.
- d. Where and to the extent permitted by law, any person(s) or organization(s) where required by written contract or written agreement with you executed prior to any "accident", including those person(s) or organization(s) directing your work pursuant to such written contract or written agreement with you, provided the "accident" arises out of operations governed by such contract or agreement and only up to the limits required in the written contract or written agreement, or the Limits of Insurance shown in the Declarations, whichever is less.

2. The following is added to the **Other Insurance** Condition in the Business Auto Coverage Form and the **Other Insurance – Primary and Excess Insurance Provisions** Condition in the Motor Carrier Coverage Form:

Coverage for any person(s) or organization(s), where required by written contract or written agreement with you executed prior to any "accident", will apply on a primary and non-contributory basis and any insurance maintained by the additional "insured" will apply on an excess basis. However, in no event will this coverage extend beyond the terms and conditions of the Coverage Form.

B. Amendment – Supplementary Payments

Paragraphs a.(2) and a.(4) of the **Coverage Extensions** Provision in **Section II – Covered Autos Liability Coverage** are replaced by the following:

2. The following is added to Paragraph 2. in the Exclusions of **Section III – Physical Damage Coverage** of the **Business Auto Coverage Form** and Paragraph 2.b. in the Exclusions of **Section IV – Physical Damage Coverage** of the **Motor Carrier Coverage Form**:

This exclusion does not apply to covered "autos" participating in a driver safety program event, such as, but not limited to, auto or truck rodeos and other auto or truck agility demonstrations.

E. Lease or Loan Gap Coverage

The following is added to the **Coverage Provision** of the **Physical Damage Coverage Section**:

Lease Or Loan Gap Coverage

In the event of a total "loss" to a covered "auto", we will pay any unpaid amount due on the lease or loan for a covered "auto", less:

- a. Any amount paid under the **Physical Damage Coverage Section** of the Coverage Form, and
- b. Any:
 - (1) Overdue lease or loan payments at the time of the "loss";
 - (2) Financial penalties imposed under a lease for excessive use, abnormal wear and tear or high mileage;
 - (3) Security deposits not returned by the lessor;
 - (4) Costs for extended warranties, credit life insurance, health, accident or disability insurance purchased with the loan or lease; and
 - (5) Carry-over balances from previous leases or loans.

F. Towing and Labor

Paragraph **A.2.** of the **Physical Damage Coverage Section** is replaced by the following:

We will pay up to \$75 for towing and labor costs incurred each time a covered "auto" of the private passenger type is disabled. However, the labor must be performed at the place of disablement.

G. Extended Glass Coverage

The following is added to Paragraph **A.3.a.** of the **Physical Damage Coverage Section**:

If glass must be replaced, the deductible shown in the Declarations will apply. However, if glass can be repaired and is actually repaired rather than replaced, the deductible will be waived. You have the option of having the glass repaired rather than replaced.

H. Hired Auto Physical Damage – Increased Loss of Use Expenses

The **Coverage Extension** for **Loss Of Use Expenses** in the **Physical Damage Coverage Section** is replaced by the following:

Loss Of Use Expenses

For Hired Auto Physical Damage, we will pay expenses for which an "insured" becomes legally responsible to pay for loss of use of a vehicle rented or hired without a driver under a written rental contract or written rental agreement. We will pay for loss of use expenses if caused by:

 - (3) Collision only if the Declarations indicate that Collision Coverage is provided for any covered "auto".
- However, the most we will pay for any expenses for loss of use is \$100 per day, to a maximum of \$3000.

I. Personal Effects Coverage

Personal Effects Coverage

- a. We will pay up to \$750 for "loss" to personal effects which are:
 - (1) Personal property owned by an "insured"; and
 - (2) In or on a covered "auto".
- b. Subject to Paragraph a. above, the amount to be paid for "loss" to personal effects will be based on the lesser of:
 - (1) The reasonable cost to replace; or
 - (2) The actual cash value.
- c. The coverage provided in Paragraphs a. and b. above, only applies in the event of a total theft of a covered "auto". No deductible applies to this coverage. However, we will not pay for "loss" to personal effects of any of the following:
 - (1) Accounts, bills, currency, deeds, evidence of debt, money, notes, securities, or commercial paper or other documents of value.
 - (2) Bullion, gold, silver, platinum, or other precious alloys or metals; furs or fur garments; jewelry, watches, precious or semi-precious stones.
 - (3) Paintings, statuary and other works of art.
 - (4) Contraband or property in the course of illegal transportation or trade.
 - (5) Tapes, records, discs or other similar devices used with audio, visual or data electronic equipment.

Any coverage provided by this Provision is excess over any other insurance coverage available for the same "loss".

J. Tapes, Records and Discs Coverage

1. The Exclusion in Paragraph B.4.a. of Section III - Physical Damage Coverage in the Business Auto Coverage Form and the Exclusion in Paragraph B.2.c. of Section IV - Physical Damage Coverage in the Motor Carrier Coverage Form does not apply.
2. The following is added to Paragraph 1.a. Comprehensive Coverage under the Coverage Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

We will pay for "loss" to tapes, records, discs or other similar devices used with audio, visual or data electronic equipment. We will pay only if the tapes, records, discs or other similar audio, visual or data electronic devices:

- (a) Are the property of an "insured"; and
- (b) Are in a covered "auto" at the time of "loss".

The most we will pay for such "loss" to tapes, records, discs or other similar devices is \$500. The Physical Damage Coverage Deductible Provision does not apply to such "loss".

K. Airbag Coverage

The Exclusion in Paragraph **B.3.a. of Section III – Physical Damage Coverage** in the Business Auto Coverage Form and the Exclusion in Paragraph **B.4.a. of Section IV – Physical Damage Coverage** in the Motor Carrier Coverage Form does not apply to the accidental discharge of an airbag.

L. Two or More Deductibles

The following is added to the **Deductible Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:**

If an accident is covered both by this policy or Coverage Form and by another policy or Coverage Form issued to you by us, the following applies for each covered "auto" on a per vehicle basis:

Any "auto" you do not own when used with the permission of its owner as a temporary substitute for a covered "auto" you do own but is out of service because of its:

1. Breakdown;
 2. Repair;
 3. Servicing;
 4. "Loss"; or
 5. Destruction.
2. The following is added to the Paragraph **A. Coverage Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:**

Temporary Substitute Autos – Physical Damage

We will pay the owner for "loss" to the temporary substitute "auto" unless the "loss" results from fraudulent acts or omissions on your part. If we make any payment to the owner, we will obtain the owner's rights against any other party.

The deductible for the temporary substitute "auto" will be the same as the deductible for the covered "auto" it replaces.

O. Amended Duties In The Event Of Accident, Claim, Suit Or Loss

Paragraph **a. of the Duties In The Event Of Accident, Claim, Suit Or Loss Condition** is replaced by the following:

- a. In the event of "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss", you must give us or our authorized representative prompt notice of the "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss". However, these duties only apply when the "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss" is known to you (if you are an individual), a partner (if you are a partnership), a member (if you are a limited liability company) or an executive officer or insurance manager (if you are a corporation). The failure of any

agent, servant or employee of the "insured" to notify us of any "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss" shall not invalidate the insurance afforded by this policy.

include, as soon as practicable:

- (1) How, when and where the "accident" or "loss" occurred and if a claim is made or "suit" is brought, written notice of the claim or "suit" including, but not limited to, the date and details of such claim or "suit";
- (2) The "insured's" name and address; and
- (3) To the extent possible, the names and addresses of any injured persons and witnesses.

If you report an "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss" to another insurer when you should have reported to us, your failure to report to us will not be seen as a violation of these amended duties provided you give us notice as soon as practicable after the fact of the delay becomes known to you.

P. Waiver of Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us

The following is added to the **Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us** Condition:

This Condition does not apply to the extent required of you by a written contract, executed prior to any "accident" or "loss", provided that the "accident" or "loss" arises out of operations contemplated by such contract. This waiver only applies to the person or organization designated in the contract.

Q. Employee Hired Autos – Physical Damage

Paragraph **b.** of the **Other Insurance** Condition in the **Business Auto Coverage Form** and Paragraph **f.** of the **Other Insurance – Primary and Excess Insurance Provisions** Condition in the **Motor Carrier Coverage Form** are replaced by the following:

For **Hired Auto Physical Damage** Coverage, the following are deemed to be covered "autos" you own:

- (1) Any covered "auto" you lease, hire, rent or borrow; and
- (2) Any covered "auto" hired or rented under a written contract or written agreement entered into by an "employee" or elected or appointed official with your permission while being operated within the course and scope of that "employee's" employment by you or that elected or appointed official's duties as respect their obligations to you.

However, any "auto" that is leased, hired, rented or borrowed with a driver is not a covered "auto".

R. Unintentional Failure to Disclose Hazards

The following is added to the **Concealment, Misrepresentation Or Fraud** Condition:

However, we will not deny coverage under this Coverage Form if you unintentionally:

- (1) Fail to disclose any hazards existing at the inception date of this Coverage Form; or
- (2) Make an error, omission, improper description of "autos" or other misstatement of information.

You must notify us as soon as possible after the discovery of any hazards or any other information that was not provided to us prior to the acceptance of this policy.

S. Hired Auto – World Wide Coverage


Paragraph **7a.(5)** of the **Policy Period, Coverage Territory** Condition is replaced by the following:

- (5) Anywhere in the world if a covered "auto" is leased, hired, rented or borrowed for a period of 60 days or less,

T. Bodily Injury Redefined

The definition of "bodily injury" in the **Definitions** Section is replaced by the following:

"Bodily injury" means bodily injury, sickness or disease, sustained by a person including death or mental anguish, resulting from any of these at any time. Mental anguish means any type of mental or emotional illness or disease.



U. Expected Or Intended Injury

The **Expected Or Intended Injury** Exclusion in Paragraph B. Exclusions under Section II – Covered Auto Liability Coverage is replaced by the following:

Expected Or Intended Injury

"Bodily injury" or "property damage" expected or intended from the standpoint of the "insured". This exclusion does not apply to "bodily injury" or "property damage" resulting from the use of reasonable force to protect persons or property.

V. Physical Damage – Additional Temporary Transportation Expense Coverage

Paragraph A.4.a. of Section III – Physical Damage Coverage is replaced by the following:

4. Coverage Extensions

a. Transportation Expenses

We will pay up to \$50 per day to a maximum of \$1,000 for temporary transportation expense incurred by you because of the total theft of a covered "auto" of the private passenger type. We will pay only for those covered "autos" for which you carry either Comprehensive or Specified Causes of Loss Coverage. We will pay for temporary transportation expenses incurred during the period beginning 48 hours after the theft and ending, regardless of the policy's expiration, when the covered "auto" is returned to use or we pay for its "loss".

W. Replacement of a Private Passenger Auto with a Hybrid or Alternative Fuel Source Auto

The following is added to Paragraph A. Coverage of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

In the event of a total "loss" to a covered "auto" of the private passenger type that is replaced with a hybrid "auto" or "auto" powered by an alternative fuel source of the private passenger type, we will pay an additional 10% of the cost of the replacement "auto", excluding tax, title, license, other fees and any aftermarket vehicle upgrades, up to a maximum of \$2500. The covered "auto" must be replaced by a hybrid "auto" or an "auto" powered by an alternative fuel source within 60 calendar days of the payment of the "loss" and evidenced by a bill of sale or new vehicle lease agreement.

To qualify as a hybrid "auto", the "auto" must be powered by a conventional gasoline engine and another source of propulsion power. The other source of propulsion power must be electric, hydrogen, propane, solar or natural gas, either compressed or liquefied. To qualify as an "auto" powered by an alternative fuel source, the "auto" must be powered by a source of propulsion power other than a conventional gasoline engine. An "auto" solely propelled by biofuel, gasoline or diesel fuel or any blend thereof is not an "auto" powered by an alternative fuel source.

X. Return of Stolen Automobile

The following is added to the Coverage Extension Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

If a covered "auto" is stolen and recovered, we will pay the cost of transport to return the "auto" to you. We will pay only for those covered "autos" for which you carry either Comprehensive or Specified Causes of Loss Coverage.

All other terms, conditions, provisions and exclusions of this policy remain the same.


