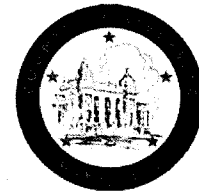

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Reaching New Heights Foundation - \$1000** funding will be used to support their mission to support veterans with utilities, housing, and food.
2. **CA Veterans of Foreign Wars Motorcycle Club, Empire Chapter - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the Emergency Food Assistance Program that serves veterans, active military families, widows, and shut-in seniors within the First District.
3. **Riverside Art Museum- \$1,000-** funding will be used to assist with the efforts to open the Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art, Culture, & Industry of the Riverside Art Museum.
4. **Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside - \$1,500** funds will assist in helping needy families in Riverside Unified School District. Kiwanis adopts 200 needy RUSD families to feed during the Thanksgiving holiday season.
5. **Riverside Free Clinic - \$1,500** funding will be used to assist with comprehensive health care for underserved Riverside residents in the First District.
