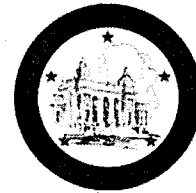

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Community Mission of Hope - \$3,500 the funding will be utilized for the food distribution program for those that are low income or experiencing homelessness in the Temecula and Murrieta areas.
2. Community Food Pantry of Murrieta - \$5,000 the funding will be used for the purchase of milk, fresh produce, and protein foods for low -income families. The Community Food Pantry of Murrieta serves 500 families on a weekly basis.
3. Art Alliance of Idyllwild - \$1,000 the funding will be utilized to support the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Art Walk to bring visitors to Idyllwild to discover the art galleries and promote businesses and general tourism in Idyllwild.
4. Valley Restart Shelter - \$10,000 the funding will be used to support general operations of the shelter and the "Bus Ticket Home Program" in which individuals who are homeless are offered the opportunity to be reunited with their families in other areas of the country.
5. Riverside University Health System Foundation - \$1,000 the funding will be utilized to support the hospital's fundraiser, "For the love of a child" which purchases crucial equipment to enable the staff to better care for children who are treated at the hospital.
6. Community Outreach Ministry - \$1,000 the funding will be used to hold "Gearing up For STEM", Mentor Protégé Workshops. The workshops include mentors who coach economically disadvantaged, high-risk and underserved students to assemble mechanical robots at Aspire Community Day School in Hemet.
