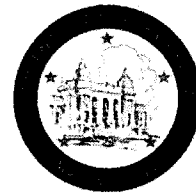



BACKGROUND:

Summary

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Jurupa Valley modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of one (1) Deputy Sheriff position. On August 1, 2019, the Jurupa Valley City Manager signed the Amendment. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the additional contract law enforcement services. Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$351,689 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2019-20. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the addition in expenditures and include them in its FY2019-20 budget.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Jurupa Valley approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and the City of Jurupa Valley, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 11, 2018, for services effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

1. Attachment A is amended to read as follows:

ATTACHMENT A

CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY

LEVEL OF SERVICE

Average Patrol Services

180 fully supported hours per day (Approximate equivalent of 37 Deputy Sheriff positions @ 1,780 annual productive hours per position standard).

Dedicated Positions

Six (6) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) position – Zone Officers

Five (5) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Traffic Enforcement Officers

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Motorcycle Enforcement Officers

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Community Oriented Policing

Four (4) Community Service Officer II positions – Traffic Enforcement
