BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges and other training providers, as well as economic development and workforce program leaders. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two year terms.

Ms. JoDee Slyter, Regional Director, ABOUT STUDENT Consortium for Adult Education, Corona-Norco Unified School District, has been an adult educator for over 28 years in the Inland

Throughout her career, she has served on a variety of committees related to adult education including the California Adult Education Strategic Planning Committee, Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment System Program Evaluation Team, Association of California School Administrators Adult Education Council, the California Adult Education Administrators' Association Executive Board, the CALPRO Advisory Board and the Riverside Workforce Development Board's Western Regional Committee among others.
