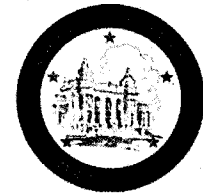



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside County Youth Commission-\$1,000: Funding will be used to support the youth commission's events and operations.
2. H.E.L.P., Inc.-\$5,000: The funds requested will be used to supports services and operations that provide much needed food staples and insure that the organization can alleviate hunger in the area.
3. The Salvation Army a California Corporation-\$2,500: Funding will support their annual event, The Inland Empire Veteran Stand Down. This event will offer services and resources, such as housing assistance, healthcare, food, clothing and mental health programs.
4. Riverside Community College District Foundation-\$5,000: Funding will be used towards the Moreno Valley College which will support their student programs, clubs and events.
