**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **Martin Luther King High School, "King High Remembers" - \$1,500** funding will be used to provide assistance with costs of the King High Remembers program, a Veterans Oral History Project.
2. **Community Outreach Ministry - \$500** funds will be used to benefit their Annual Angel Tree Christmas Tree Project which will provide food and clothing to 200+ at-risk and/or needy children (ages 0-18) whose parents are incarcerated, as well as provide them with a holiday meal.
3. **Assistance League of Temecula Valley - \$2,500** funding will be used to support the Operation School Bell program, which provides new, school appropriate clothing & shoes for students K-12 attending school districts within the First District.
