

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department conducted Engineering and Traffic Surveys (E&TS) in accordance with the California Vehicle Code (CVC), Sections 627 and 40802, for various county-maintained roads in the Murrieta, Perris, San Jacinto and Winchester areas of Riverside County.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the Transportation Department recommends designated radar-enforceable speed limits along the road segments summarized in the List of Speed Zones, and has determined these speed limits to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of vehicular traffic.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside, San Geronio, and Temecula area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) regarding the recommended speed zones.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promote safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits are based on actual speed surveys, the majority of motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$3,000.



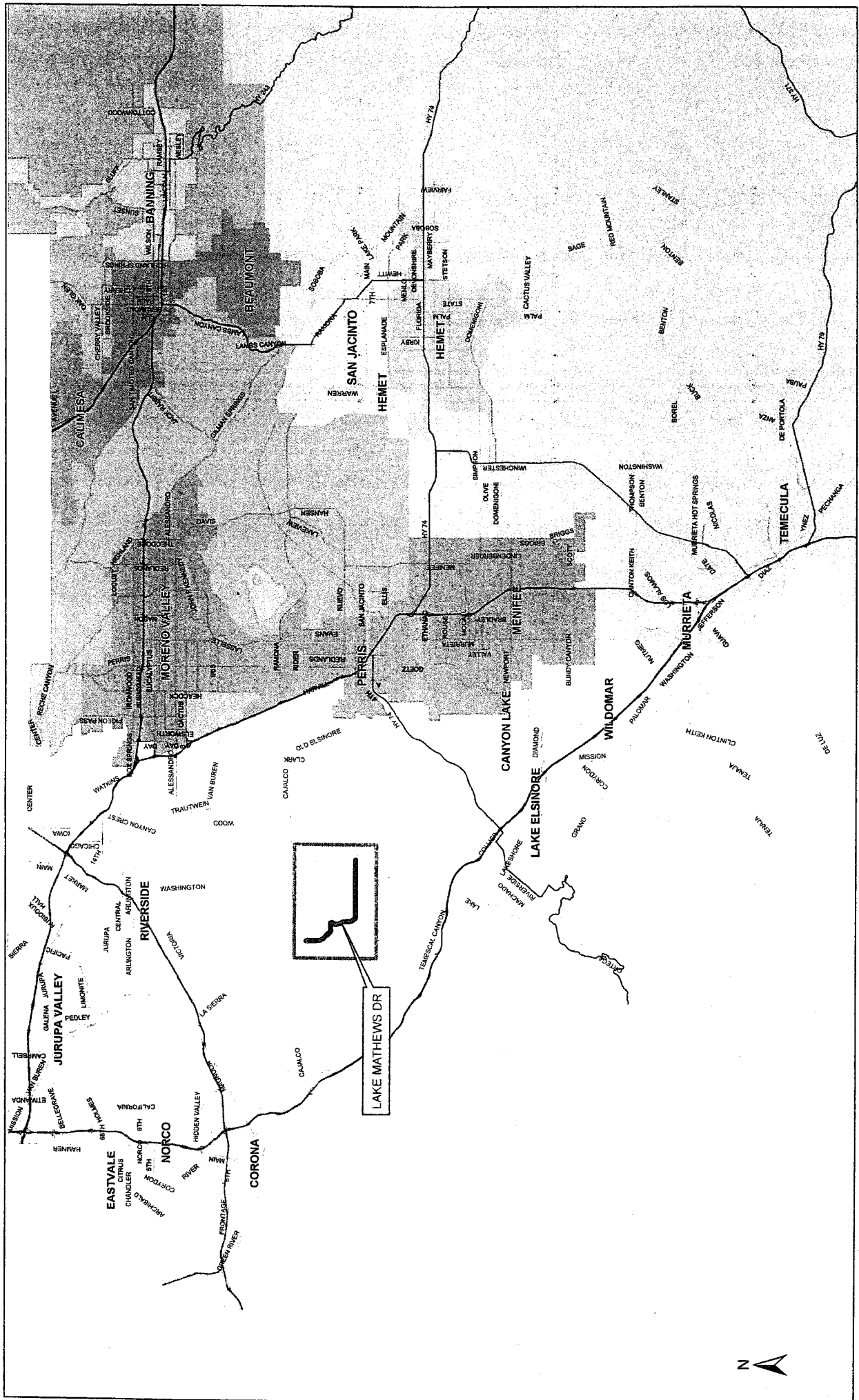

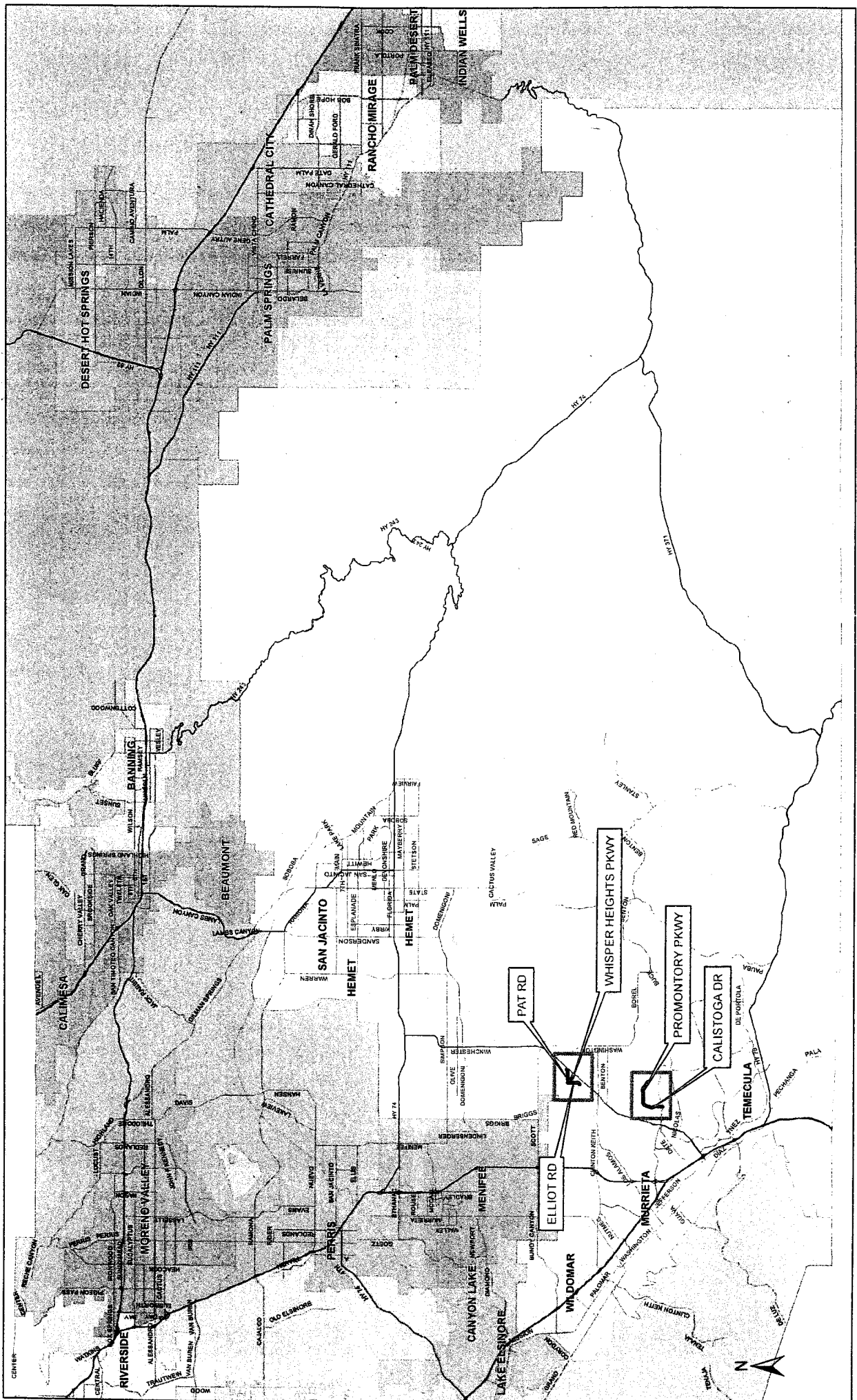

ORDINANCE 452.246 DISTRICT 1 SPEED ZONE VICINITY MAP

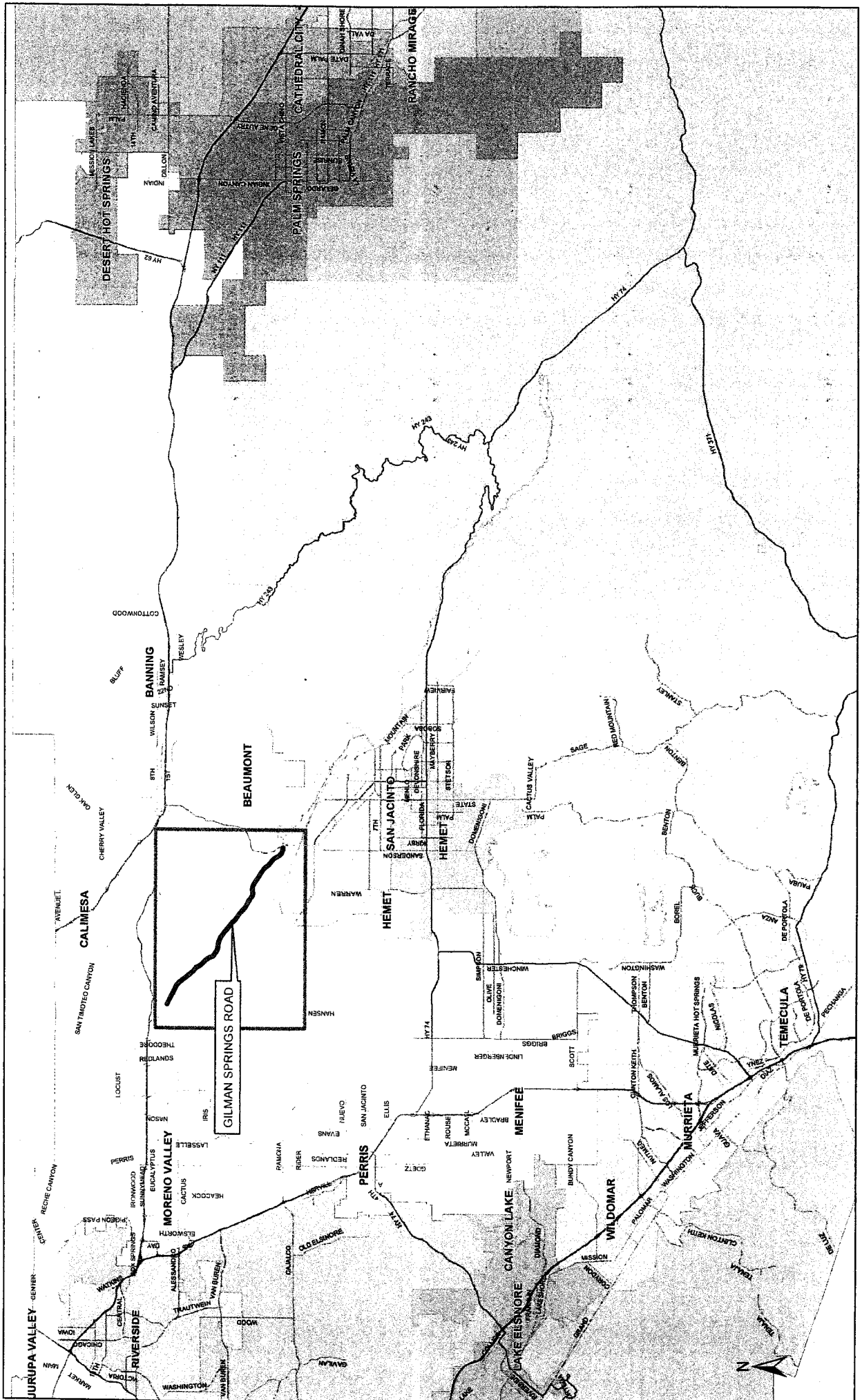


ORDINANCE 452.246 DISTRICT 3 SPEED ZONE VICINITY MAP

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452  
RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 135 and 136 to read as follows:

- "135. On Elliot Road between Jean Nicholas Road and Pat Road, a total distance of approximately 0.63 miles, in the Winchester area.  
136. On Pat Road between Elliot Road and Pourroy Road, a total distance of approximately 0.57 miles, in the Winchester area."







**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department conducted Engineering and Traffic Surveys (E&TS) in accordance with the California Vehicle Code (CVC), Sections 627 and 40802, for various county-maintained roads in the Murrieta, Perris, San Jacinto and Winchester areas of Riverside County.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the Transportation Department recommends the introduction of designated radar-enforceable speed limits along the road segments summarized in the List of Speed Zones, and has determined these speed limits to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of traffic. The Transportation Department intends to recommend adoption of these designated radar-enforceable speed limits at the October 8, 2019 Board of Supervisors meeting.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside, San Geronio and Temecula area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) regarding the recommended speed zones.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promote safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the posted speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits are based on actual speed surveys, the majority of motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$ 3,000.
