BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Transportation Department (County) in partnership with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), worked to complete the Potrero Creek Basin Project (Basin) located in the unincorporated county area of San Jacinto (Exhibit "A" – Vicinity Map). The flood control facilities consist of a debris basin with a spillway structure.

The County acquired the property needed for the Basin in the name of the County of Riverside, and now desires to turn over the property to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), as the District will be assuming full ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the Basin and its facilities. The County intends to convey fee simple interests in the real property (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 430-110-017, 430-110-018, 430-070-017, 430-070-018, and 430-140-009) by Quitclaim Deed to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District.

On or after September 24, 2019, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2019-145, Notice of Intention to Convey Fee Simple Interests in Real Property (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 430-110-017, 430-110-018, 430-070-017, 430-070-018, and 430-140-009) by Quitclaim Deed to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District located in the San Jacinto area, County of Riverside and notice was published by the Clerk of the Board pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 25365, the County of Riverside by 4/5 vote, may transfer interests in real property, or any interest therein, belonging to the County to a public agency, upon the terms and conditions as are agreed upon and without complying with any other provisions of the Government Code, if the property or interest therein to be conveyed is not required for county use.

Resolution No. 2019-146, has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to legal form.

Environmental Findings

The activity is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c), Existing Facilities, because the District will assume ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the Basin and its facilities, which involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing Basin and its facilities.

The activity is also covered by the common sense exemption, Section 15061 (b)(3), that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, therefore the activity is exempt from CEQA.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Potrero Creek Basin Project has reduced flooding in the area of Sanderson Bridge at the San Jacinto Riverside, thereby protecting property and citizens.

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside is the owner of certain real property as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this referenced incorporated herein, located in the San Jacinto area, County of Riverside, State of California within an area bounded by the Ramona Expressway and Gilman Springs Road ("Property");

WHEREAS, the County acquired the Property for flood control facilities consisting of a debris basin with a spillway structure ("Basin") for the Potrero Creek Basin Project ("Project") in the name of the County of Riverside by a Final Order of Condemnation recorded on August 21, 1997 (Instrument No. 303407) of Official Records;

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside through the Riverside County Transportation Department ("County") worked with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") to complete the Project;

WHEREAS, the Project was constructed at County's sole expense and in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the District;

WHEREAS, the Property conveyed to the County in fee simple is to be turned over to the District as the District will be assuming full ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the Basin and its facilities;

WHEREAS, the County and District concur that it would be in both parties best interest to transfer the property interests to the District by Quitclaim Deed;

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code Section 25365, the Board of Supervisors may, by a vote of not less than four-fifths, quitclaim to a public agency within the County any real property, or interests therein belonging to the County if the

property or interest therein to be quitclaimed is not required for County use; and

WHEREAS, the conveyance of the fee simple interest in real property is exempt from the provision of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Class 1 – Existing Facilities and 15061(b)(3) – Common

Sense Exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by a vote not less than four-fifths of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California ("Board"), in regular session assembled on October 22, 2019 at 9:30 AM or soon thereafter, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the first floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, that this Board finds that the conveyance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities and Section 15061 (b)(3) – Common Sense Exemption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute the Quitclaim Deed for Property to the District as the District will be assuming full ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the Basin and its facilities and return the Quitclaim Deed to Economic Development Agency to complete this conveyance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Assistant County Executive Officer/ECD or his designee to execute any other documents and administer all actions to complete this transaction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board will file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Transportation Department (County) in partnership with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), worked to complete the Potrero Creek Basin Project (Basin) located in the unincorporated county area of San Jacinto (Exhibit "A" – Vicinity Map). The flood control facilities consist of a debris basin with a spillway structure.

The County acquired the property needed for the Basin in the name of the County of Riverside, and now desires to turn over the property to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), as the District will be assuming full ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the Basin and its facilities. The County intends to convey fee simple interests in the real property (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 430-110-017, 430-110-018, 430-070-017, 430-070-018, and 430-140-009) by Quitclaim Deed to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Pursuant to Government Code Section 25365, the County of Riverside, by 4/5 vote may transfer interests in real property, or any interest therein, belonging to the County to other persons, upon the terms and conditions as are agreed upon and without complying with any other provisions of the Government Code, if the property or interest therein to be conveyed is not required for county use.

Resolution No. 2019-145 has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to legal form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Potrero Creek Basin Project has reduced flooding in the area of Sanderson Bridge at the San Jacinto Riverside, thereby protecting property and citizens.
