#### **BACKGROUND:**

## **Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing improvements at the "T" intersection of Highway 74 and Sophie Street in the Community of Good Hope in the County of Riverside, by installing traffic signalization and lighting. At this intersection, Highway 74 is a four lane highway that travels in the northeast-southwest directions with four through lanes and a left-turn lane for vehicles turning south onto Sophie Street. Sophie Street is a two-lane road that travels in the north-south direction. The area in the immediate vicinity consists of undeveloped land and rural residences.

Project construction at Highway 74 and Sophie Street will include installing traffic signal poles and hardware, minor pavement widening, installing concrete curb, sidewalk and curb ramps, removing existing traffic striping and signs, and installing new traffic striping and signs. In addition to the installation of a new signal at Highway 74 and Sophie Street, the Transportation Department is proposing traffic signal equipment upgrades at Highway 74 and Ellis Avenue, Highway 74 and Theda Street, Highway 74 and Meadowbrook Avenue, and Highway 74 and Wasson Canyon Road intersections. Street signs along the corridor will be replaced will new signs that have larger lettering and reflectivity for greater visibility.

Relinquishment of the State Highway 74 portion between the east City of Lake Elsinore boundary and west City of Perris boundary (approximately 6 miles) was adopted by the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors on January 31, 2017 (item 3.22). As part of this improvement project, the State Route 74 signs will be replaced with Highway 74 signs.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

#### **Environmental Findings**

The project proposes improvements that are consistent with CEQA section 15301 (c) because the project is a minor alteration consisting of installation of a new traffic signal and modification

of traffic signals and associated improvements. Minor alterations of a road with negligible or no expansion of use are provided for in Section 15301(c).

## **Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements. The sign replacement and signal upgrades will improve visibility and safety to drivers.

The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

## **Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$449,884. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2019/2020 and will be funded with Caltrans (Relinquishment) funds.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Highway 74/Sophie Street, upgrade signal equipment at Highway 74/Ellis Avenue, Highway 74/Theda Street, Highway 74/Meadowbrook Avenue and Highway 74/Wasson Canyon Road, and replace existing roadside signs along Highway 74 in the unincorporated Riverside County area from the City of Lake Elsinore boundary to the City of Perris Boundary. The former Highway 74 was relinquished to the County of Riverside between the eastern Lake Elsinore City limit and the western Perris City limit in January 2017, which includes the project intersections. The project will include the following:

- Installation of traffic signal poles, mast arms, signal cabinets, and pull-boxes
- Grading and minor paving
- Installation of curb
- Removal and installation of traffic striping and signs
- Installation of video detection for the traffic signals
- Installation of pedestrian ramps, safety lights, and pedestrian crossings

# **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is not within cell criteria areas and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 -September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities - The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Highway 74/Sophie Street, modify traffic signals at Highway 74/Ellis Avenue, Highway 74/Theda Street, Highway 74/Meadowbrook Avenue and Highway 74/Wasson Canyon Road, and replace signs along Highway 74 from the City of Lake Elsinore boundary to the City of Perris Boundary. The project proposes improvements that are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is a minor alteration that consists of installation of a new traffic signal and repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities including existing traffic signals with negligible or no expansion of use.


