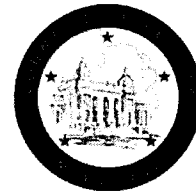



DEPARTMENT: Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for Bids for the Construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of 42nd Avenue and Adams Street in the Community of Bermuda Dunes; CEQA Exempt. District 4. [\$473,658 - 100% Local Funds] (Clerk to Advertise)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) (existing facilities);
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of 42nd Avenue and Adams Street in the Community of Bermuda Dunes;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 13, 2019 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to replace the existing 4-way stop with a new traffic signal and lighting at the intersection of 42nd Avenue and Adams Street in the Community of Bermuda Dunes, in the Coachella Valley area of the County.

Proposed improvements include installation of a traffic signal, lighting, removing and installing new concrete curb and median, and installing new traffic striping and traffic signs.

Additional improvements include removing existing concrete curb ramps and adjacent curb and gutter located at the intersection of Varner Road and Newcastle Drive and replacing them with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete curb ramps, and other work that may be required.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The 42nd Avenue and Adams Street traffic signal and lighting project proposes improvements that are consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301(c) because the project is a minor alteration that consist of installation of a new traffic signal as well as maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities with negligible or no expansion of use. Furthermore, the project proposes to improve safety conditions in the existing intersection by installing traffic signal and safety lights that are consistent with CEQA Section 15301(f) because the project consists of addition of safety protections for use in conjunction with an existing facility.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$473,658. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2019/2020 and will be funded with East County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of 42nd Avenue and Adams Street in Bermuda Dunes within unincorporated Riverside County. 42nd Avenue is a four-lane facility that travels in the East-West directions with a 12-foot wide raised median. Inside through lanes are 12' wide and outside through lanes are 19' wide. Adams Street is a two-lane facility that travels in the North-South directions with 12-foot wide through lanes, curb, gutter, and sidewalk. The area in the immediate vicinity is low and medium density residential developments. The project will include the following:

- Installation of traffic signal poles, mast arms, signal cabinets, and pull-boxes
- Installation of video detection for the traffic signals
- Installation of safety lights
- Replacement of sidewalk
- Minor asphalt patching
- Removal and installation of traffic striping and signs
- Removal and installation of curb and median
- Removal of vegetation/trees
- Utility relocations

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements from private property will be obtained.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside conservation areas. This project is not within conservation areas and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Coachella Valley MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).
