#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### <u>Summary</u>

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) was granted appurtenant interests for the construction and maintenance of the Santa Ana River and levee located just beyond the county limits in San Bernardino County ("SBC") from William M. Kirkpatrick and Emma Mae Kirkpatrick per Grant Deed recorded in Book 3980, Pages 50-51, on July 6, 1956, records of San Bernardino County, California. The rights granted therein included the temporary right to construct and borrow material, and a permanent easement right to operate, maintain and flood said property. The property is located within that certain property identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN) 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15 and referenced as RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6 ("ROW").

The property owner of APNs 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15 ("Applicant") has requested that the District vacate its easement rights in the ROW. A floodplain study dated August 21, 2019 was prepared by JLC Engineering on behalf of the Applicant. The report has been reviewed by the District, and it has been determined that the proposed ROW relinquishment does not adversely impact the floodplain.

The action is exempt from CEQA because it qualifies as a "Class 12 Categorical Exemption" pursuant the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15312, "Surplus Government Property Sales." The project is also consistent with Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense" exemption, because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment, as it is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement for parcels that are no longer needed, nor will be needed in the future for the District's use and purposes.

District staff has determined that the easement rights granted within the ROW and APNs 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15 are no longer necessary pursuant to site improvements. The rights herein described have been declared excess and are not required for the District's use and purposes pursuant to the adoption of Resolution No. F2019-21 on September 17, 2019.

Therefore, the District recommends that the ROW, being the right of way dedicated in Book 3980, Pages 50-51, on July 6, 1956, also shown on Record of Survey, Book 22, Pages 36 through 47, inclusive, records of San Bernardino County, State of California, be summarily vacated and relinquished.

Resolution No. F2019-22 has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

All associated costs with this action shall be borne by Applicant.

AUTHORIZATION TO SUMMARILY VACATE AND RELINQUISH DISTRICT RIGHT OF WAY WITHIN THE SANTA ANA RIVER, IN THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO, RCFC PARCELS 1010-5 AND 1010-6, SANTA ANA RIVER, PROJECT NO. 1-0-00010

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") is the owner of certain real property interests over land identified with Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN) 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15, which was granted via grant deed recorded in Book 3980, Pages 50-51 on July 6, 1956, records of San Bernardino County, by William M. Kirkpatrick and Emma Mae Kirkpatrick, known as RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6 ("ROW"). The rights granted therein include the temporary right to construct and borrow material, and a permanent easement right to operate, maintain and flood said property for Santa Ana River and levees, located in the County of San Bernardino ("SBC"); and

WHEREAS, no flood control improvements have been constructed within the ROW, and the underlying fee owner of APNs 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15 (collectively, the "Property"), Howard Industrial Partners (the "Applicant"), has applied for and obtained a Conditional Use Permit ("CUP") from San Bernardino County to use the Property for a parking lot and to store trailers. The District reviewed the floodplain study prepared by the Applicant dated August 21, 2019, and it has been determined that the proposed ROW relinquishment does not adversely impact the floodplain; and

WHEREAS, the ROW shall no longer be necessary for the use and rights therein granted, and the Applicant has requested the District vacate RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6 and its rights in the ROW; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the District's Board of Supervisors ("Board") adopted Resolution No. F2019-21 declaring the ROW as surplus that is no longer needed for the District's use and purposes, and provided notice of its intention to summarily vacate and relinquish the ROW; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Water Code Appendix Chapter 48, Sections 48-9, Paragraph 5, and Section 48-13, the District may dispose of real property after adoption of a resolution determining that said real property is no longer necessary to be retained for the District's use and purposes, as was previously adopted and determined in Resolution No. F2019-21; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed and determined the summary vacation and relinquishment of the ROW is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15312, "Surplus Government Property Sales," as the District is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement because the easement interest is no longer needed for the District's use and purposes. Furthermore, the action is also consistent with State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense" exemption, because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the vacation and relinquishment of the disturbed ROW may have a significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by vote of the Board of Supervisors of the District, in regular session assembled on October 22, 2019, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the District located on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at 9:30a.m. or soon thereafter, based on the review of the proposed vacation and relinquishment, that the proposed action qualifies for a "Class 12 Categorical Exemption" pursuant to Article 19 of the CEQA, State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15312 and Section 15061(b)(3) as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question will have a significant effect on the environment because the District is merely vacating an unnecessary right of way on disturbed property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by vote of this Board, that this Board authorizes the summary vacation and relinquishment of the ROW, RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6, that certain real property located in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, more particularly described in Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California



#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary**

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") was granted appurtenant interests for the construction and maintenance of the Santa Ana River and levee located just beyond the county limits in San Bernardino County ("SBC") from William M. Kirkpatrick and Emma Mae Kirkpatrick per Grant Deed recorded in Book 3980, Pages 50-51 on July 6, 1956, records of San Bernardino County, California. The rights granted therein included the temporary right to construct and borrow material, and a permanent right to operate, maintain and flood said property. The property is located within that certain property identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 0260-131-14 and 0260-131-15 and referenced as RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6 ("ROW").

The property owner ("Applicant") has requested that the District vacate its easement rights in the ROW. A floodplain study dated August 21, 2019 was prepared by JLC Engineering on behalf of the property owner. The report has been reviewed by the District and it has been determined that the proposed ROW relinquishment does not adversely impact the floodplain.

The District recommends that the right of way easements located within RCFC Parcels 1010-5 1010-6, as dedicated in Book 3980 Pages 50-51 on July 6, 1956, also shown on Record of Survey, Book 22, Pages 36 through 47, inclusive, records of San Bernardino County, State of California, be declared surplus to the District's needs pursuant to Water Code — Appendix, Chapter 48, Section 48-9, Paragraph 5, and Section 48-13, as the easement rights are no longer necessary for District's use and purpose. The adoption of Resolution No. F2019-21 will prompt the District's notice of intention to summarily vacate and relinquish the District Right of way along the Santa Ana River located within RCFC Parcels 1010-5 and 1010-6.

Resolution No. F2019-21 has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

All associated costs with this action shall be borne by the Applicant.
