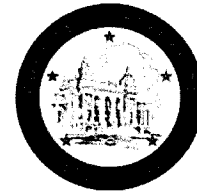

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Janet Goeske Foundation- \$5,000-** funding will be used to support comprehensive programs and services for adults who are 50 and older in the First District.
2. **A Salute to Veterans Parade Committee - \$2,500** funding will be used to support the Salute to Veterans Parade that will be held on November 9, 2019 in Riverside. The event is free and open to the public.
3. **California Baptist University - \$2,000** funding will be used to support CBU's efforts to provide a spectrum of psychological services to children, adults, couples and families in the Casa Blanca neighborhood at a very reduced cost to those who may not be able to afford it.
