

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,000 the funding will be used toward an event, which recognizes exceptional businesses, service/charitable organizations and individuals for demonstrating strong community involvement in the Temecula Valley.
2. Boy Scouts of America - \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to support low-income scholarships for boy scouts that need financial support to attend camp.
3. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Inland Empire - \$2,500 the funding will be used to support the Road to Success, Building Resiliency and Academic Achievement One-to-One Mentoring Program.
4. The Salvation Army - \$5,000 the funding will be used for the Salvation Army meal program, which provides weekend meals and snacks for low-income children.
5. Riverside County EDA - \$10,000 the funding will be used to support the 2019 French Valley Air Show. A free family community event in the unincorporated areas of the Riverside County Third District.
