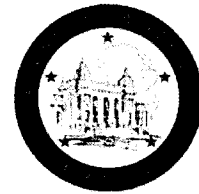





**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. March Air Field Museum - \$10,000: Funding will be used to support the programs at March Air Museum that offer the opportunity to experience history and allow constituents to interact with aviation experts.
2. Riverside University Health System Foundation - \$10,000: The funds requested will be used to purchase new medical equipment, support programs and assist with continuing education of the medical professionals.
3. Trauma Intervention Programs (TIP) - \$1,000: Funding will be used to support first responders of the district and the efforts that TIP has dedicated to ensuring that those who are emotionally traumatized in emergency situations receive the assistance that they need.
