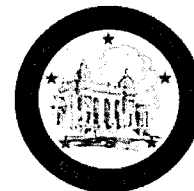



**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Voices for Children - \$3,000: The organization will use the funds to provide advocacy to three foster children living in the Fifth District.
2. District Attorney Crime Prevention Foundation - \$2,500: The organization will use the funds to provide community-building opportunities through events that combine education with fun for the whole family.
3. Riverside County Foundation on Aging - \$5,000: The organization will use the funds for direct assistance in providing a means of purchasing food for needy seniors in the communities, and help reduce senior hunger, isolation and depression during the holiday season.
