BACKGROUND:

Summary

On October 2, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Minute Order 3.8 approving the Riverside County Public, Educational, and Governmental (PEG) Channel Plan and template of the Use Agreement for Riverside County's PEG Channel (RivCoTV). Until recently, the Clerk of the Board oversaw RivCoTV and staff.

In order to align with the County's effort to have information technology services managed by Riverside County Information Technology (RCIT) department, RivCoTV dedicated staff have been transferred to RCIT. The staff have now been integrated into RCIT operations. The transfer allows for efficient utilization of the County's technology resources.

With RivCoTV now managed by RCIT, the department requests authorization be granted to the Assistant County Executive Officer/CIO to sign future Use Agreements with governmental entities who desire to broadcast government-related programming on RivCoTV that is consistent with the Peg Channel Plan. The Use Agreement, as approved by the Board of Supervisor on October 2, 2018, will provide the terms and conditions that will govern (1) the broadcast on RivCoTV of content submitted to the County by such government entities, and (2) any production services provided by the County at the request of such government entities. The costs and expenses incurred by the County for these items would be paid for by the government entities under the Use Agreement.

Along with the transfer of staff, current and future RivCoTV revenue and expenses will also be transferred to RCIT. The department requests that the Auditor-Controller make the budget adjustments as reflected in the Schedule A and deactivate fund 11187 Board of Supervisors-PEG.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no negative impact to residents of the County of Riverside.
