BACKGROUND:

Summary

Ordinance No. 457 establishes and implements the building standards contained in the California Building Standards Code and other state law for the unincorporated area of the County of Riverside.

The California Building Standards Code is updated in its entirety every three years by order of the California legislature. The most recent update to the California Building Standards Code occurred in 2019 and will become effective January 1, 2020. As a result, the County of Riverside is required to adopt by ordinance the most recent California Building Standards Code. The County may also establish more restrictive building standards than the California Building Standards Code by making express findings that the more restrictive building standards are reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological or topographical conditions.

Based on revisions to state law, there is a need for an update to Ordinance No. 457 to ensure compliance with the recently updated 2019 California Building Standards Code.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no impact on residents and businesses at this time. The amendment to Ordinance No. 457 will be considered for adoption at a future Board of Supervisors hearing.

Additional Fiscal Information

According to Board Policy A-67, the Board of Supervisors is to consider the costs associated with preparing, processing and implementing an ordinance amendment in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the amendment. The estimated cost of preparing, processing and implementing this amendment is \$10,000.00, which will be paid by the Building and Safety Department. This amount is based on the need for an amendment to Ordinance No. 457. No additional money from the general fund is requested for this project.
