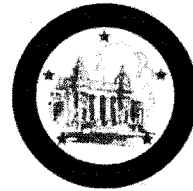

BACKGROUND:

On September 20, 2019 the Riverside County Parks District received news that a long time and retired Parks District employee, Ranger John Vint, lost his short battle with liver cancer. Ranger John Vint served the District and the County for over 37 years and is credited with establishing, operating and maintaining Anza Narrow-Martha McLean Park, Hidden Valley Wildlife Area and the Arundo Removal Crew (Team Arundo) within the Santa Ana River.

Based upon Ranger Vint's commitment, dedication and years of service to Riverside County and the Parks District, the District Advisory Commission voted unanimously to approve and recommended to the Board of Supervisors the naming of the lower staging area for Hidden Valley Wildlife Area as the Ranger John Vint Staging Area.
