

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the combined construction of the Harrison Street Safety Improvements Project, between 54th Avenue and 81st Avenue, in the Community of Thermal; and San Timoteo Canyon Road Safety Improvements Project, between Redlands Boulevard and the City of Beaumont limit, in the San Timoteo Canyon Area of the County.

Harrison Street is a north-south, two lane, roadway classified as an urban arterial with an existing posted speed limit of 55 miles-per-hour (mph). The segment of Harrison Street, between 54th Avenue and 81st Avenue is approximately 13.5 miles in length.

San Timoteo Canyon Road is an east-west, two lane, roadway classified as a collector road with an existing speed limit of 55 mph. San Timoteo Canyon Road is a direct route between the cities of Loma Linda, Redlands, Beaumont and Calimesa. The segment of San Timoteo Canyon Road between Redlands Boulevard and the City of Beaumont is approximately 6 miles in length.

The proposed safety improvements include installation of a centerline rumble stripe to help alert drivers who may stray from the travel lanes, upgrading the existing painted striping with thermoplastic material making them much easier to see at night or in bad weather conditions when visibility is poor, installation and upgrade of various signs with fluorescent sheeting for brighter traffic signs that appear to glow, even at dawn, dusk or with overcast skies, installation of four solar powered radar signs to raise the speed awareness of oncoming drivers, and other incidental work that may be required.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to provide safety improvements along San Timoteo Canyon Road and Harrison Street. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the proposed safety improvements do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

In addition, the project is exempt under CEQA under Section 15301 (f) because it proposes to install safety protection devices for use on the existing facility such as a centerline rumble stripe and four solar powered radar signs, as well as upgrade signage and striping.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed improvements will enhance traffic safety by providing installation of a centerline rumble stripe, upgrading existing striping with thermoplastic striping, installing and upgrading various signs with fluorescent sheeting, and installing four solar powered radar signs (two on Harrison Street and two on San Timoteo Canyon Road).

Construction will start in early 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately three months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$804,844 and will be funded with Gas Tax funds, and with Highway Safety Improvement Program funds for which the Department successfully competed.



If there is a difference between the minimum wage rates predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and the general prevailing wage rates determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations for similar classifications of labor, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the higher wage rate. The Department will not accept lower State wage rates not specifically included in the Federal minimum wage determinations. This includes "helper" (or other classifications based on hours of experience) or any other classification not appearing in the Federal wage determinations. Where Federal wage determinations do not contain the State wage rate determination otherwise available for use by the Contractor and subcontractors, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the Federal minimum wage rate, which most closely approximates the duties of the employees in question.

The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) provides a toll-free "hotline" service to report bid rigging activities. Bid rigging activities can be reported Mondays through Fridays, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., eastern time, Telephone No. 1-800-424-9071. Anyone with knowledge of possible bid rigging, bidder collusion, or other fraudulent activities should use the "hotline" to report these activities. The "hotline" is part of the DOT's continuing effort to identify and investigate highway construction contract fraud and abuse and is operated under the direction of the DOT Inspector General. All information will be treated confidentially and caller anonymity will be respected.

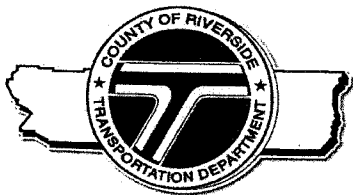

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to provide roadway safety improvements along San Timoteo Canyon Road and Harrison Street. San Timoteo Canyon Road is an east-west, two-lane, high speed roadway classified as a Collector in the Riverside County General Plan. Harrison Street is a north-south, two lane, high speed roadway classified as an Urban Arterial in the Riverside County General Plan. Safety improvements will be from Redlands Boulevard to the City of Beaumont Limits along San Timoteo Canyon Road, approximately 6 miles in length, and between 54th Avenue and 81st Avenue along Harrison Street, approximately 13.5 miles in length. The proposed project will include the following:

- Installation of a centerline and rumble strip
- Upgrade existing painted striping with thermoplastic striping
- Installation/upgrade signs with fluorescent sheeting
- Installation of four solar powered radar signs
- Utility relocation/coordination

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas. This project is an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 15 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).


The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to provide safety improvements along San Timoteo Canyon Road and Harrison Street. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the proposed safety improvements do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Section 15301 (f) – Existing Facilities – The need for this project is based off the results of a completed Roadway Safety Audit that identified safety concerns. The project proposes to install a centerline, rumble strip and four solar powered radar signs, as well as upgrade signage and striping. The project is exempt under CEQA under Section 15301 (f) because it proposes the addition of safety protection devices for use on the existing facilities.
