#### ORDINANCE NO. 452.246 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452 RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 135 and 136 to read as follows:  
"135. On Elliot Road between Jean Nicholas Road and Pat Road, a total distance of approximately 0.63 miles, in the Winchester area.  
136. On Pat Road between Elliot Road and Pourroy Road, a total distance of approximately 0.57 miles, in the Winchester area."
- Section 2. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 154, 155, and 156 to read as follows:  
"154. On Calistoga Drive between Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Richmond Way/Greenhaven Way, a total distance of approximately 1.14 miles, in the Murrieta area.  
155. On Promontory Parkway between Richmond Way/Greenhaven Way and Pourroy Road, a total distance of 0.80 miles, in the Murrieta area.  
156. On Whisper Heights Parkway between Elliot Road and SH-79/Winchester Road, a total distance of approximately 0.40 miles, in the Winchester area."
- Section 3. Section 2.6 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 92 to read as follows:  
"92. On Lake Mathews Drive, between Catalco Road and Gavilan Road, a total distance of approximately 5.11 miles, in the Perris area."
- Section 4. Section 2.7 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 30 to read as follows:  
"30. On Gilman Springs Road, between 200 feet north of Kevin Road and SH-79, a total distance of approximately 8.80 miles, in the San Jacinto area."
- Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.



ORDINANCE NO. 767.23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 767 DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY TREASURER TO INVEST AND REINVEST FUNDS OF THE COUNTY AND OTHER DEPOSITORS AND TO DEPOSIT FOR SAFEKEEPING CERTAIN INSTRUMENTS IN IDENTIFIED FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:  
Section 1. Ordinance No. 767 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 767  
AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE  
DELEGATION OF INVESTMENT AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY TREASURER

Section 1. Purpose. The authority to invest or to reinvest funds of a local agency, or to sell or exchange securities so purchased for a period of one year from the effective date of this ordinance with such delegation expiring on November 23, 2020. The County Treasurer shall assume full responsibility for these transactions until the Board of supervisors either revokes this delegation of authority by ordinance or until the delegation expires. The Board of Supervisors may renew this delegation of authority for subsequent on-year periods by adopting an amendment to this ordinance.

Section 2. Statutory Authority. Pursuant to Government Code Section 27000.1 and subject to Government Code Section 53607, the Board of Supervisors may by ordinance delegate to the County Treasurer, for a one-year period, the authority to invest or reinvest funds of the County and the funds of other depositors in the county treasury. Pursuant to Government Code Section 53608 the Board of Supervisors may delegate to the County Treasurer the authority to deposit for safekeeping certain instruments in identified financial institutions.

Section 3. Delegation of Authority. The County Board of Supervisors hereby delegates to the County Treasurer:

- The authority to invest or to reinvest funds of a local agency, or to sell or exchange securities to purchase for a period of one-year from the effective date of this ordinance with such delegation expiring on November 23, 2020. The County Treasurer shall assume full responsibility for these transactions until the Board of Supervisors either revokes this delegation of authority by ordinance or until the delegation expires. The Board of Supervisors may renew this delegation of authority for subsequent one-year periods by adopting an amendment to this ordinance.
- The authority to deposit for safekeeping certain instruments in identified financial institutions as provided in Government Code Section 53608. The delegation of this authority shall continue until the Board of Supervisors revokes this delegation of authority by ordinance.
- The authority to enter into such contracts for services that are ancillary to, and in the reasonable professional judgment of the County Treasurer, necessary or beneficial for the proper administration of the investment or reinvestment of funds of the County and other depositors.

Section 4. Monthly Report. The County Treasurer shall make a monthly report of the investments and reinvestments that he has made pursuant to the authority delegated by this ordinance.

Section 5. Effect on Existing Law. Nothing in this ordinance shall limit the County Treasurer's authority to invest excess funds of the County or another local agency as provided in Government Code Section 53864 or to make pooled investments in commercial paper as provided in Government Code Sections 53635.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision, clause, sentence or paragraph of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
