BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Alfred E. Alquist Seismic Safety Act (the "Act") established seismic safety building standards under the jurisdiction of the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) for hospitals built on or after March 7, 1973. The goal is to ensure general acute care hospitals in California are capable of weathering a seismic event of up Magnitude 6.5 on the Richter Scale and continue to operate.

An initial structural assessment was conducted at the RUHS Medical Center. The findings determined that all buildings at the RUHS Medical Center campus are currently in compliance with the structural provisions of the Act but need upgrades to non-structural elements which includes additional bracing, anchoring, and onsite stores of supplies, to be compliant with the 2030 standards.

Passed in September 2018, Assembly Bill 2190 requires the Board of Directors of acute care inpatient hospitals to submit to OSHPD an attestation that it is aware of the standards that the hospital is required to meet by January 1, 2030. It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the adoption of Resolution No. 2019-235, which provides the Assembly Bill 2190 Attestation to OSHPD.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Compliance with the Alfred E. Alquist Seismic Safety Act will ensure the RUHS Medical Center continues to provide critical trauma and acute care services for Riverside County and its residents.

10 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2190 (2018) added several sections to the California Health &
11 Safety Code regarding seismic safety regulations and standards for acute care inpatient hospitals; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 130066 of the Code provides in pertinent part that before January 1,
13 2020, owners of acute care inpatient hospitals whose building does not substantially comply with the
14 regulations or standards described in Section 130065 shall submit an attestation to the Office of Statewide
15 Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) that they are aware that the hospital building is required to
16 meet the January 1, 2030 deadline for substantial compliance; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is the governing body that oversees the operation of
18 the Riverside University Health System Medical Center; and

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
20 Riverside, in regular session assembled on December 17, 2019, that the Board does hereby attest that it
21 is aware that the Riverside University Health System – Medical Center is required to meet the January 1,
22 2030 deadline for substantial compliance with the regulations and standards described in California
23 Health & Safety Code section 130065.

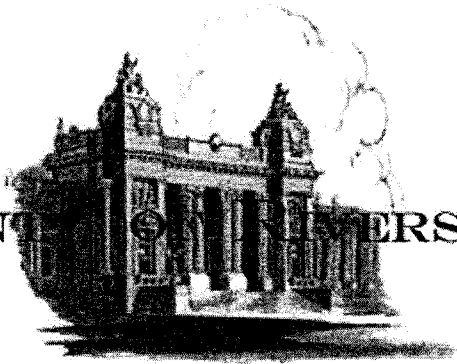
