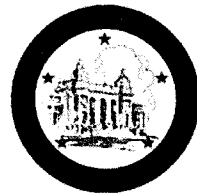



All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notices of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Transportation Department proposes to resurface five roads in the Desert Edge Community in the Coachella Valley area of Riverside County. The following roads are included:

18th Avenue	650 feet west of Langlois Rd.	to	300 feet east of Langlois Rd.	950
Aurora Road	Langlois Rd.	to	630 feet west of Corkill Rd.	3,200
Clifton Street	Langlois Rd.	to	690 feet east of Langlois Rd.	690
Corkill Road	Dillon Rd.	to	2,700 feet south of Dillon Rd	2,700
Langlois Road	Aurora Rd.	to	Clifton Street	2,700

The five roads are being combined to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to seek more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions, generally associated with age and extreme temperature changes. The proposed resurfacing projects include removal of the existing asphalt concrete pavement and the placement of new asphalt concrete pavement.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of concrete cross gutters, spandrels, curb and gutter, driveways, asphalt concrete dike, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The roads included in the Desert Edge Resurfacing Project are five of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid:	Resurfacing and associated road improvements
Alternative Bid Schedule 1:	Langlois Road, Healing Waters Mobile Home Park Frontage Improvements
Alternative Bid Schedule 2:	Langlois Road, Tamarisk Mobile Home Park Frontage Improvements

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**Environmental Findings**

The project proposes to resurface segments of 18th Avenue, Aurora Road, Clifton Street, Corkill Road and Langlois Road. This proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing of the roadways does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of 18th Avenue, Aurora Road, Clifton Street, Corkill Road and Langlois Road in the Community of Desert Edge, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin early 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately six weeks to complete.

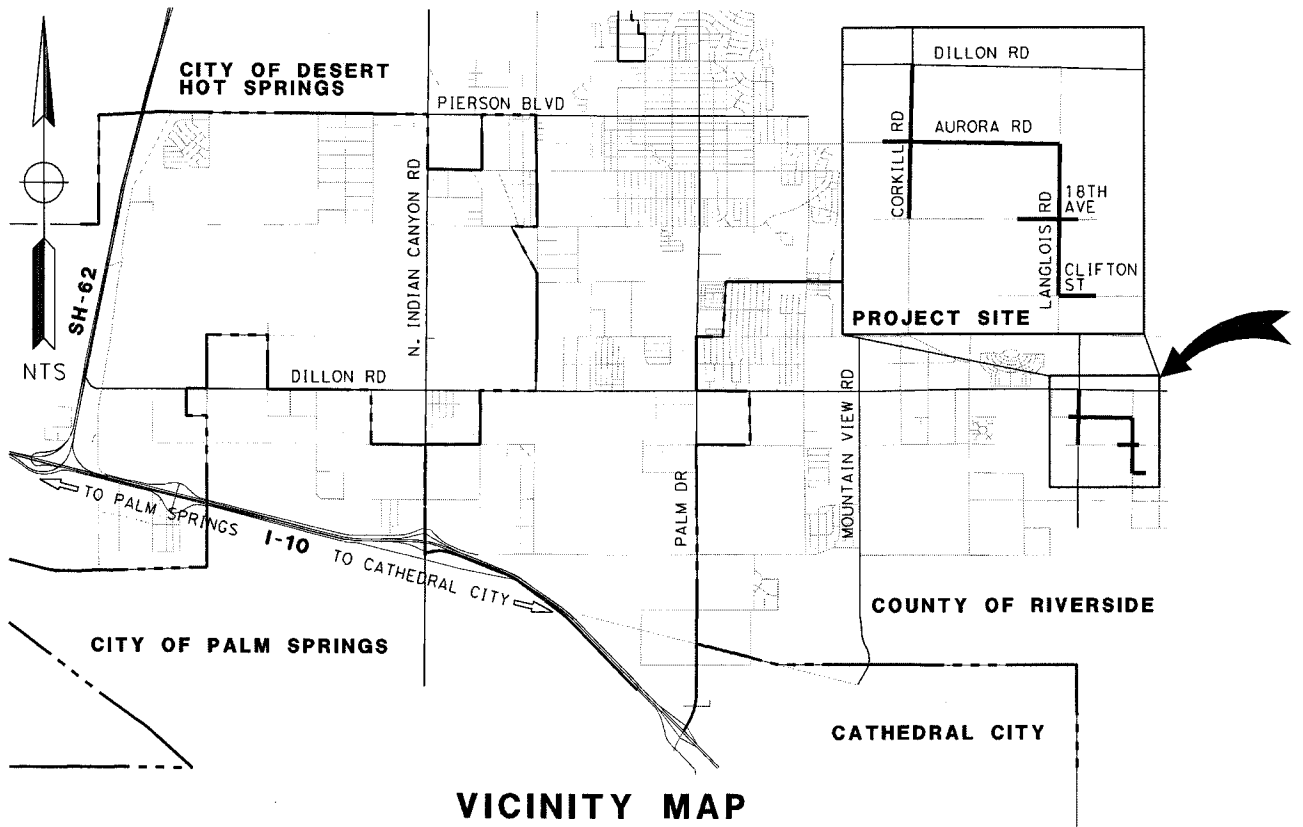
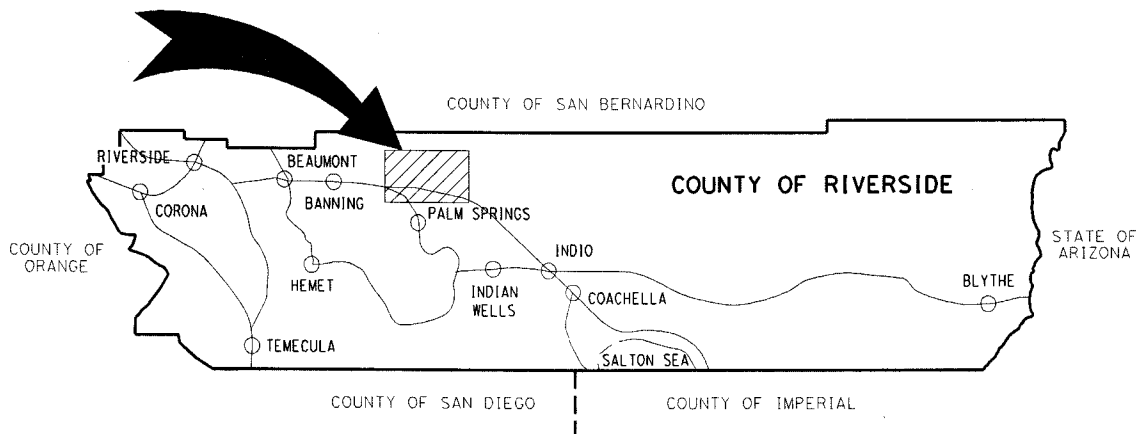

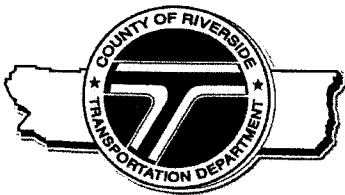

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** 4<sup>th</sup>

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface the following road segments:

- Approximately 950 feet of 18th Avenue from 600 feet west of Langlois Road to 300 feet east of Langlois Road. 18th Avenue is 32 feet wide with curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway.
- Approximately 3,200 feet of Aurora Road from Langlois Road to 630 feet west of Corkill Road. Aurora Road currently ranges from 28-40 feet wide with curb/gutter along the north half of the roadway.
- Approximately 600 feet of Clifton Street from Langlois Road to 600 feet east of Langlois Road will be resurfaced. Clifton Street currently ranges from 38-42 feet wide with curb/gutter along both sides of the roadway.
- Approximately 2,600 feet of Corkill Road from Dillon Road to 1400 feet south of Dillon Road. Corkill Road currently ranges from 23-57 feet wide with curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway.
- Approximately 2,700 feet of Langlois Road from Aurora Road to Clifton Street is proposed to be resurfaced. Langlois Road currently ranges from 34-58 feet wide with curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway.

The proposed project will include the following:

- Removal of the roadway and pavement with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Utility adjustments
- Vegetation removal
- Installation of new pavement markers
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Reconstruction of curb, cross-gutter, driveways and walkways
- Construction of asphalt concrete driveways and dike.

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity.

If tree or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season from March 1 to September 1, a pre-construction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

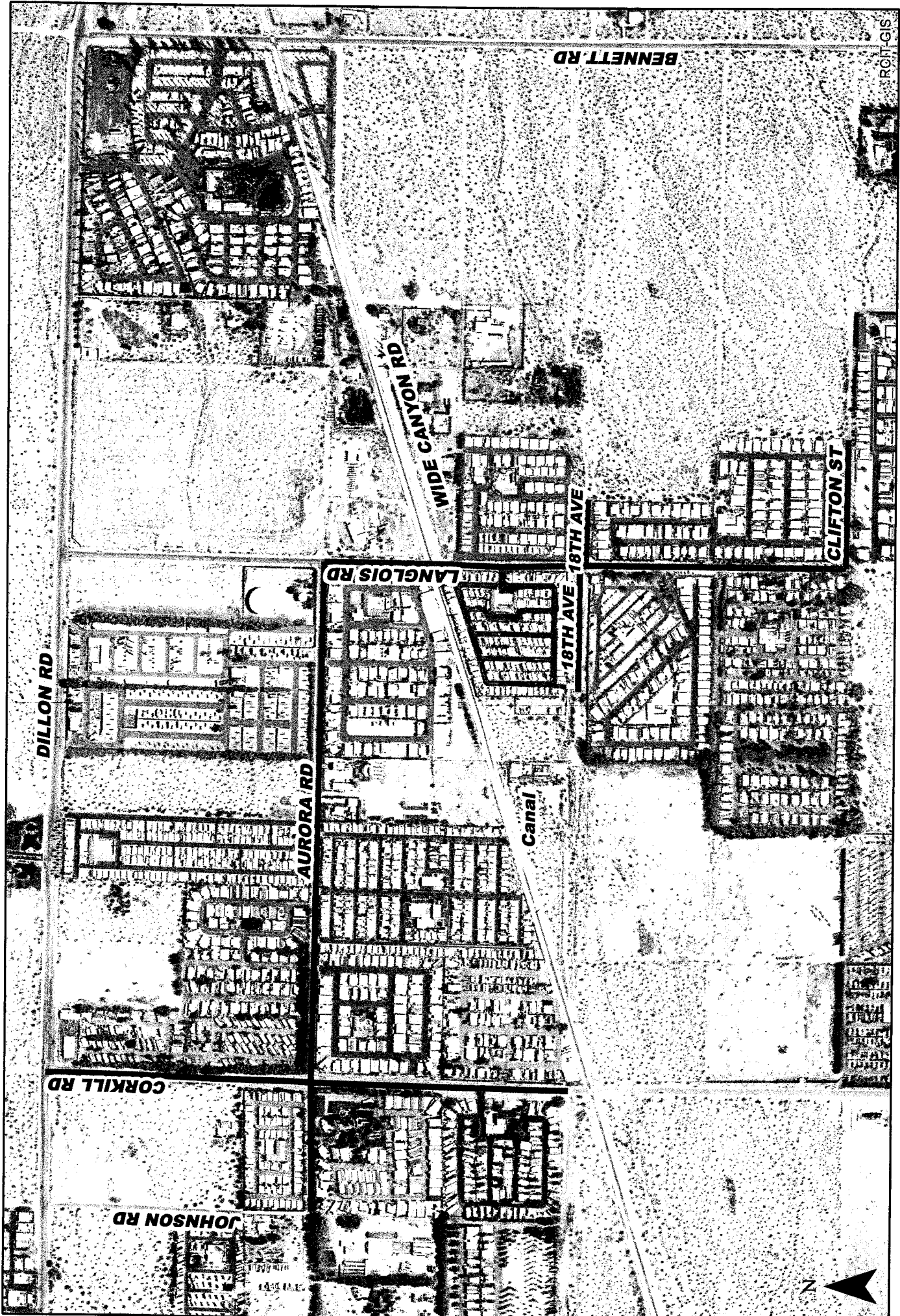
