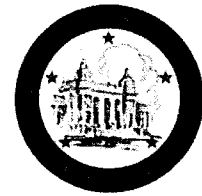





**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Rubberized Emulsion Aggregate Slurry (REAS) treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The REAS treatment, similar to a conventional slurry, seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve the underlying pavement structure. REAS consists of a modified asphalt binder and ground tire rubber originating from recycled passenger car tires. The use of modified asphalt and ground tire makes the REAS more durable and improves the elastic properties of the material thereby increasing the service life of the material. However, the cost of REAS is twice as much as the cost of a conventional slurry. The proposed REAS project will serve as a pilot project in order to evaluate and document the performance of the material and provide analysis of the cost effectiveness of the material. This project includes various roads located within the 3rd and 5th Supervisorial Districts, in particular within the Communities of Valle Vista and Cherry Valley. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

This project proposes REAS treatment based on the existing pavement conditions. The REAS treatment consists of an application of a mixture of emulsified asphalt, crumb rubber (from recycled tires), aggregates, water, portland cement and other additives, mixed at a central plant, then applied over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes pavement surface cleaning, crack repairs, application of REAS, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times, at specified intervals, after the REAS has been applied.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid: Rubberized Emulsion Asphalt Slurry, Districts 3 and 5.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**Environmental Findings**

The project proposes to apply the REAS treatment on various road locations within Districts 3 and 5. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c) because the REAS treatment on various roads does not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadways and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The REAS treatment will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$420,407 and construction is anticipated to be completed in FY 2019/2020. The REAS project will be funded with Measure A/Western, and Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.



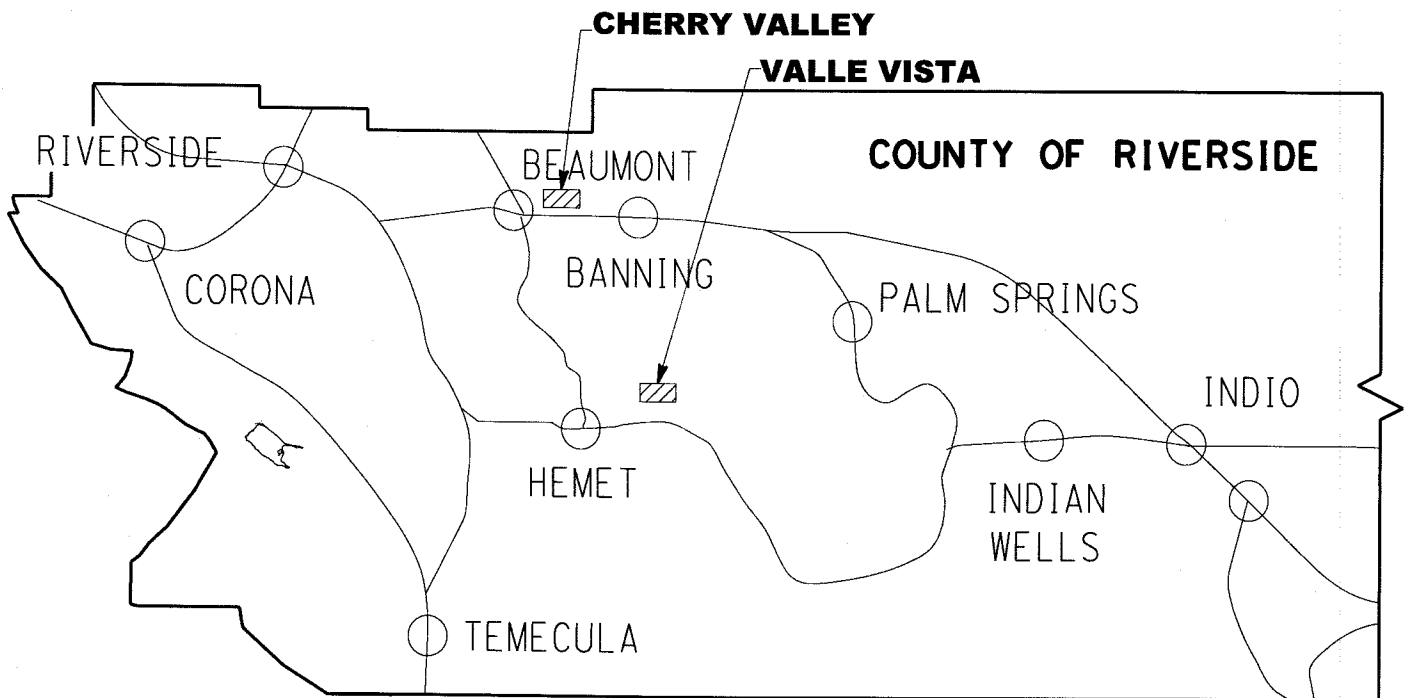
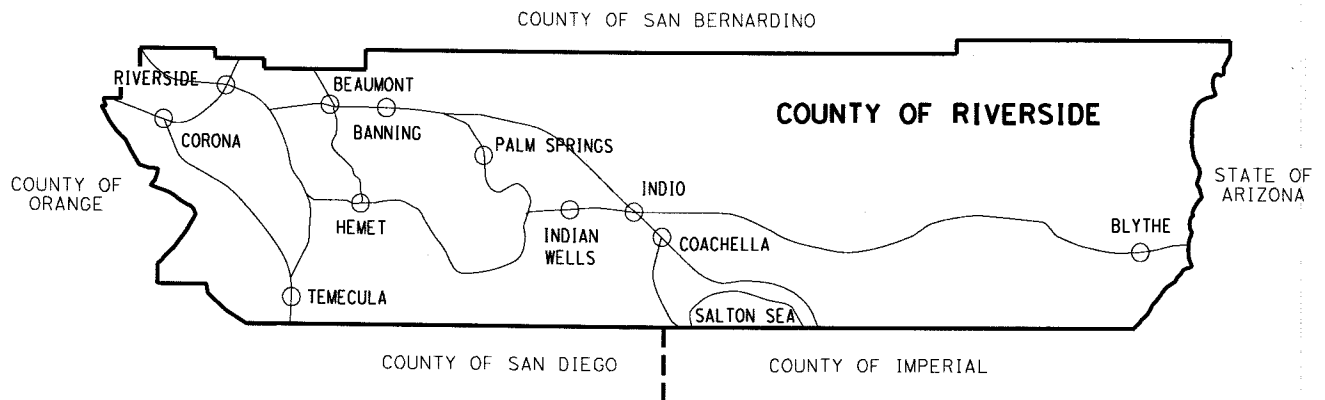

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** 3 & 5

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to provide rubberized emulsion aggregate surfacing (REAS) treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads located within the communities of Cherry Valley and Valle Vista.

REAS treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt, crumb rubber, latex, aggregate (very small crushed rock), water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. REAS treatments seal cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface, provide a new black pavement surface color, and help preserve the underlying pavement structure.

The work also involves removing and replacing thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings/paint traffic stripes and other work as may be required.

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing county right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas. The project consists of maintenance and repair of existing public roads. The project is considered to be safety improvement project under operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

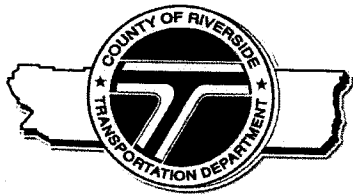

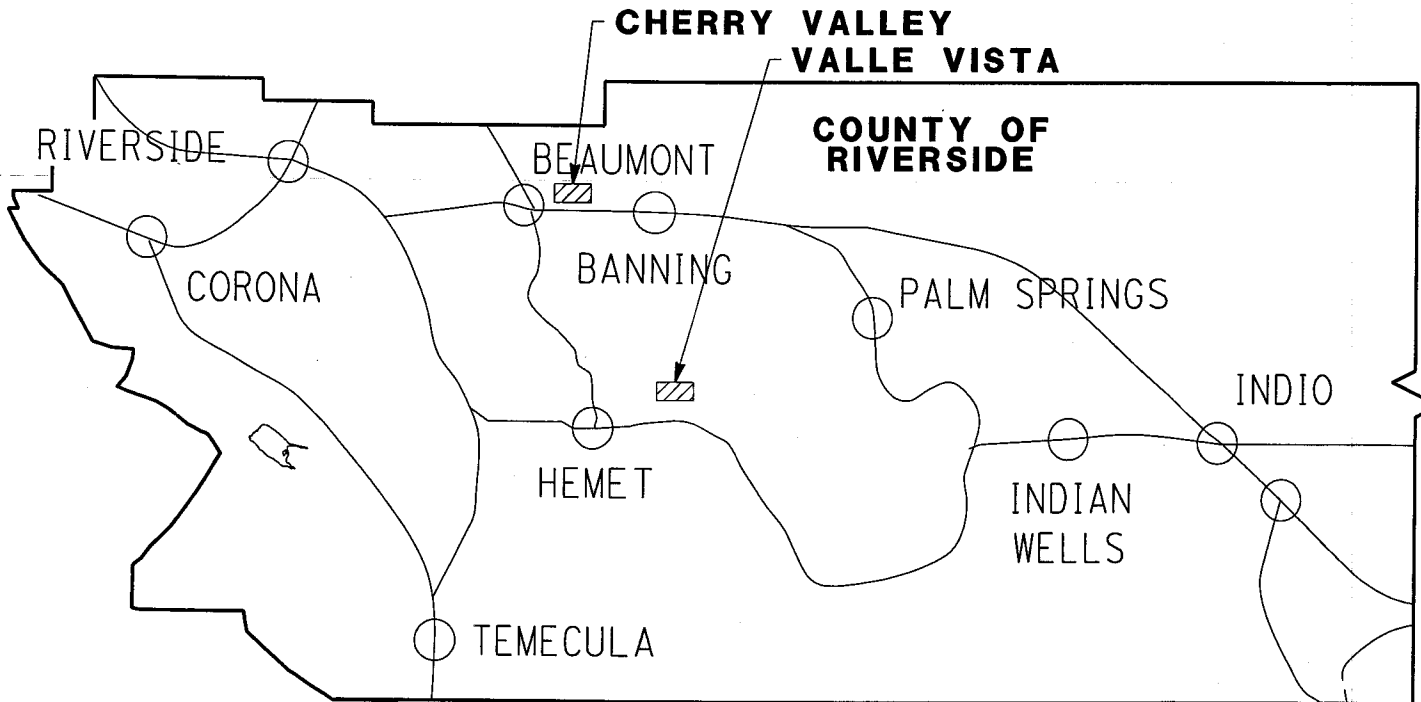
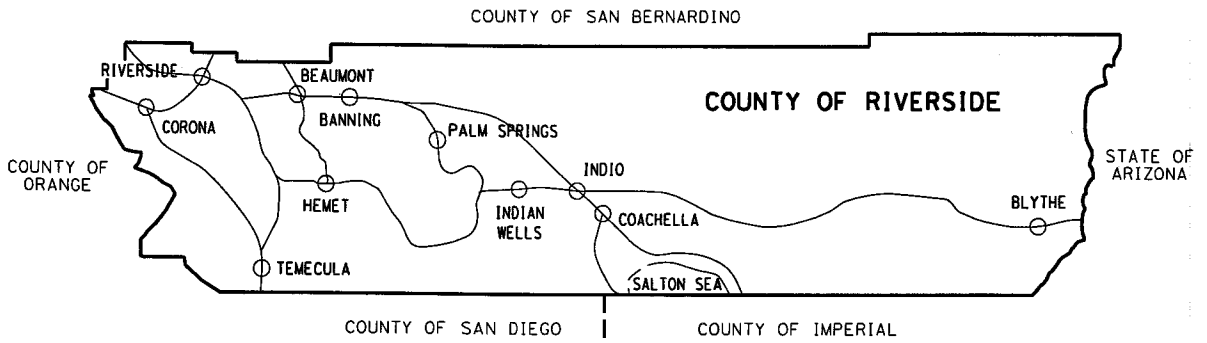
