BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Superior Court and the County worked cooperatively to find a permanent Chief Probation Officer. The County publicly announced the recruitment for the position and conducted a review of all prospective candidates in accordance with the requirements and criteria identified in the public announcement of the open position. Pursuant to an MOU between the Court and the County, a Selection Committee comprised of two judges, two members of the Board of Supervisors, and the chief executive officers of the Court and the County was formed to conduct oral interviews of the qualified candidates. After careful review and consideration of the applications and interviews, the committee found that Ronald L. Miller, II was the most qualified applicant for the position, meeting and/or exceeds the announced requirements and criteria for the position.

Pursuant to law, the Court submitted Ronald L. Miller, II's name to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission (JJJPC) for nomination. The JJJPC met and formally nominated Ronald L. Miller, II for the position of Chief Probation Officer and submitted that nomination to the Presiding Judge.

On January 23, 2020, the Presiding Judge appointed Ronald L. Miller, II to serve as the Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County.

It is recommended that Ronald L. Miller, II be approved as the Chief Probation Officer with an annual salary of \$209,799.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

APPOINTMENT OF RONALD L. MILLER,
II AS CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER
FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY

The Court finds as follows:

On or about June 24, 2019, Mark Hake announced his retirement and tendered his resignation as Chief Probation Officer for Riverside County, effective September 11, 2019.

The Court and County worked cooperatively to find a permanent replacement.

The County publicly announced the recruitment of the position of the Chief Probation Officer and conducted a review of all prospective candidates in accordance with the requirements and criteria identified in the public announcement of the open position.

The Court and the County formed a Selection Committee comprised of judicial officers, county elected officials, and executive leadership staff to conduct oral interviews of the qualified candidates. After careful review and consideration of the applications and interviews, the committee found that Ronald L. Miller, II is the most qualified applicant for the position and meets and/or exceeds the announced requirements and criteria for the position.

The Court submitted Ronald L. Miller, II's name to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission (JJDP) for nomination.



The JJDC met and approved a motion to formally nominate Ronald L. Miller, II for the position of Chief Probation Officer.

Based on the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Ronald L. Miller, II is appointed Chief Probation Officer of the Count of Riverside effective forthwith. Ronald L. Miller, II will act as the Chief Probation Officer for both adult and juvenile services.
2. Ronald L. Miller, II shall assume all of the duties and responsibilities of Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County as prescribed by the relevant job description, statutes, regulations and laws governing said duties and responsibilities.
3. In light of this ORDER, the position of Interim Chief Probation Officer, previously held by Ronald L. Miller, II, is terminated forthwith.
