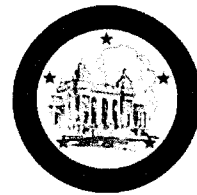





BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports the development of the regional workforce and economic expansion. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities, community colleges, and/or other training providers, as well as economic development and workforce program leaders. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the local business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two year terms.

Rosibel Ochoa, Ph.D. is the Associate Vice Chancellor of Technology Partnerships within the Office of Research and Economic Development at the University of California, Riverside (UCR). As Vice Chancellor of Technology Partnerships, Dr. Ochoa is tasked with stimulating commercialization, entrepreneurship and new company formation at UCR. She also plays a critical role in fostering a regional innovation ecosystem with the commercial sector and federal, state, county and city governments. Dr. Ochoa has a Ph.D. in Chemical Engineering from the University of Louisville and has extensive experience in education, entrepreneurship and public/private partnerships.

Dr. Rosibel Ochoa is being recommended to serve as an Education Representative for the Riverside County Workforce Development Board for All Districts. If reappointed, she will serve a two-year term commencing January 23, 2020 and ending January 23, 2022.
