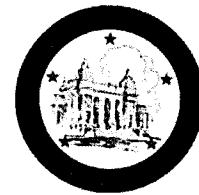

**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to Big Brothers Big Sisters will be used to continue to provide mentoring to over 200 youth in the Second District.
2. The donation to ABC Hopes will be used to sponsor their annual fundraiser. All funds from this event will be used to provide services to individuals with intellectual disabilities, including increased social interaction through farmers markets, improved physical activity through fitness programs, increased independence through an empowerment model and a reduction in the risk of obesity as measured through quarterly body analysis.
3. The donation to Soroptimist International of Riverside will be used to sponsor their annual "Live Your Dream" Conference which is designed to inspire seventh and eighth grade girls to live their dream by introducing them to women in various professions, such as finance and technology, medical and science, governmental services, entrepreneurship and performing and visual arts.
4. The donation to LULAC of Riverside (League of Latino American Citizens) will help sponsor their annual health fair which provides dental, optical or medical services to those in need.
