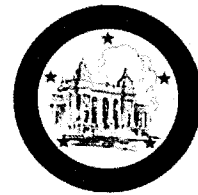



4. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated October 22, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.23), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of 42nd Avenue and Adams Street in the Community of Bermuda Dunes, in the Coachella Valley area of the County of Riverside.

Improvements include installing traffic signal poles with mast-arms, safety lighting, and traffic signal cabinets, grading, minor asphalt concrete pavement patching, replacement of existing sidewalk, removing and installing concrete curb and median, removing existing traffic striping, installing new traffic striping, removing existing traffic signs, and installing new traffic signs.

Additional improvements include removing existing concrete curb ramps and adjacent curb and gutter located at the intersection of Varner Road and Newcastle Drive and replacing them with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete curb ramps, and other work that may be required.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addendum was issued to modify the approved contract documents to include revisions pertaining to the project liquidated damages. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The contractor, California Professional Engineering, Inc. is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal and safety lighting will improve traffic and pedestrian safety by providing controlled traffic movements and intersection visibility.

The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2019/2020.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to California Professional Engineering, Inc. for the total amount of \$441,634.

The project will be funded with East County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Seven bids were received on Wednesday November 13, 2019 ranging from \$441,634 to \$538,506. Three of the seven received bids were lower than the Engineer's Estimate. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by California Professional Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$441,634 which is \$32,023 (6.7%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, California Professional Engineering, Inc.

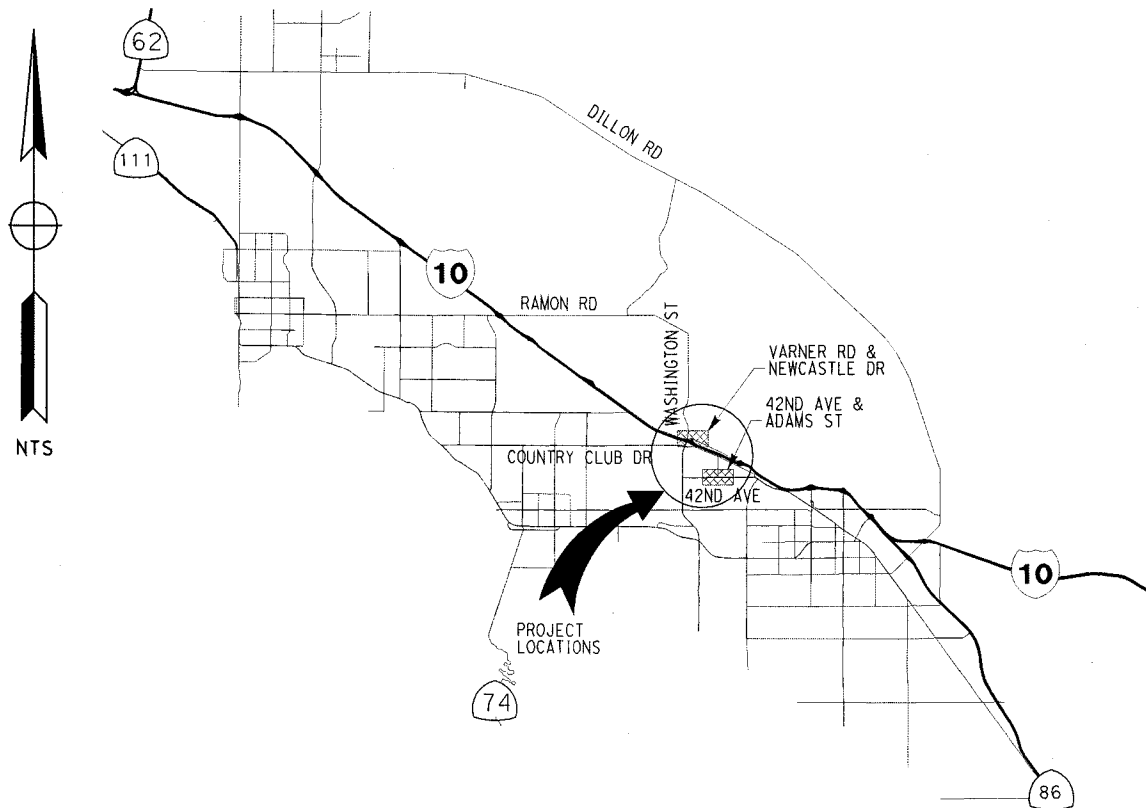
