BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated October 29, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.18), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Curb Ramp Accessibility Project in the communities of Mecca and Bermuda Dunes and as part of the Transportation Department's goal to provide safe and usable pedestrian facilities for all pedestrians and to comply with the Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. As part of the ADA requirements, curb ramps must be upgraded when adjoining roads are altered through resurfacing or placement of a thick layer of seal coat. The specific curb ramp locations are listed in "Attachment 1".

The curb ramp upgrades within these communities coincide with the proposed slurry seal project for fiscal year 2019-2020 District 4, which will be applied after the curb ramp work is completed. For Districts 1, 2, 3 and 5, similar work for curb ramp upgrades and application of slurry seal is currently being worked on and additional work will be completed on upcoming projects.

On March 12, 2013 (agenda item 3.50), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 2013-024 adopting the "Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan for Access in the Public Road Right-of-Way" prepared by the Transportation Department.

The Transportation Department is responsible for administering the ADA compliance program for accessible pedestrian facilities within the public road right-of-way.

The Curb Ramp Accesibility project will consist of modifying or removing existing concrete curb ramps and placing back ADA compliant concrete curb ramps. Additionally, proposed upgrades to existing curb ramps will consist of installing yellow detectable warning devices typically consisting of a series of small bumps (or truncated domes) and repairs to street landing slopes to meet ADA compliance. Detectable warning devices alert pedestrians who are blind or visually impaired that there is passing traffic.

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The contract includes two base bid schedules of work:

Base Bid 1: Items of Work Under Project No. D0-0009

Base Bid 2: Items of Work Under Project No. C4-0052

The Transportation Department recommends award of the Contract in the amount of \$468,595.

The contractor, LC Paving and Sealing, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The curb ramps accessibility project is expected to improve access and safety of pedestrians with disabilities. In addition, bringing the curb ramps up to current accessibility standards contributes toward fulfilling the Transportation Department's goals as stated in its ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan for Access in the Public Road Right-of-Way as required by Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2019/20 and will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA, Measure A – Coachella Valley, and SB 821 (Local Transportation Funds).

The SB 821 funds were secured through a Countywide process in which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Eight bids were received on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 ranging from \$468,595 to \$945,074. Three of the eight received bids were lower than the Engineer's Estimate. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

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All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by LC Paving & Sealing, Inc. in the amount of \$468,595 which is \$134,505 (22.3%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, LC Paving & Sealing, Inc.

4. That the contract shall be awarded upon a resolution or minute order to that effect duly adopted by the governing body of County; and that execution of the Contract shall constitute a written memorial thereof.
5. To submit to the County such information as County may require determining whether a particular Bid is the lowest responsible bid submitted.
6. That the accompanying Bid Bond, certified check or cashier's check is in an amount not less than 10% of the total bid submitted and constitutes a guarantee that if awarded the contract, Contractor will execute the Contract and deliver the required bonds within ten (10) business days after notice of award. If Contractor fails to execute and deliver said documents, the bond or check is to be charged with the costs of the resultant damages to the County, including but not limited to: publication costs, the difference in money between the amount bid and the amount in excess of the bid which it costs County to do or cause to be done for the work involved, lease and rental costs, additional salaries and overhead, increased interest and costs of funding the project, attorney expense, additional engineering and architectural expense and cost of maintaining or constructing alternate facilities occasioned by the failure to execute and deliver said documents.



P. RENTAL REIMBURSEMENT COVERAGE

1. This coverage applies only to a covered "auto" for which Physical Damage Coverage is provided on this policy
2. We will pay for rental reimbursement expenses incurred by you for the rental of an "auto" because of "loss" to a covered "auto". Payment applies in addition to the otherwise applicable amount of each coverage you have on a covered "auto." No deductibles apply to this coverage.
3. We will pay only for those expenses incurred during the policy period beginning 24 hours after the "loss" and ending, regardless of the policy's expiration, with the lesser of the following number of days:
 - a The number of days reasonably required to repair or replace the covered "auto". If "loss" is caused by theft, this number of days is added to the number of days it takes to locate the covered "auto" and return it to you.
 - b The number of days shown in the Schedule.
4. Our payment is limited to the lesser of the following amounts:
 - a. Necessary and actual expenses incurred
 - b. \$75 for any one day or for a maximum of 30 days.
5. This coverage does not apply while there are spare or reserve "autos" available to you for your operations.
6. If "loss" results from the total theft of a covered "auto" of the private passenger type, we will pay under this coverage only that amount of your rental reimbursement expenses which is not already provided for under SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE Coverage Extension.

Q EXPANDED TRANSPORTATION EXPENSE

Paragraph A.4.a. of SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE is replaced by the following:

We will pay up to \$50 per day to a maximum of \$1500 for temporary transportation expense incurred by you because of the total theft of a

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covered "auto" of the private passenger type. We will only pay for those covered "autos" for which you carry Comprehensive or Specified Causes of Loss Coverage. We will pay for temporary transportation expenses incurred during the period beginning 24 hours after the theft and ending, regardless of the policy's expiration, when the covered "auto" is returned to use or we pay for its "loss".

R. EXTRA EXPENSE - STOLEN AUTOS

The following paragraph is added to Coverage Extensions of SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE.

c. We will pay for up to \$5,000 for the expense of returning a stolen covered "auto" to you. We will pay only for those covered "autos" for which you carry Comprehensive or Specified Causes of Loss Coverage.

S. PHYSICAL DAMAGE LIMIT OF INSURANCE

Under SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE, Paragraph C., Limit of Insurance is replaced by the following:

C. Limit Of Insurance

1. The most we will pay for "loss" in any one "accident" is the lesser of:
 - a. The actual cash value of the damaged or stolen property as of the time of the "loss", or

b. If a repair or replacement results in better than like kind or quality, we will not pay for the amount of the net improvement.

5. If we offer to pay the actual cash value of the damaged or stolen property, we will value auto advertising wraps, paint customization, and similar business related advertising modifications, in addition to the actual cash value of the property. Auto advertising wraps, paint customization, and similar business related advertising modifications will be valued at the cost to replace them with an adjustment made for depreciation and physical condition.

T. NEW VEHICLE REPLACEMENT COST

The following is added to the Limit of Insurance provision of SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE:

5. The provisions of paragraphs 1. and 3. do not apply to a covered "auto" of the private passenger type or a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 20,000 pounds or less which is a "new vehicle"

In the event of a total "loss" to your new vehicle to which this coverage applies, we will pay at your option:

- a. The verifiable "new vehicle" purchase price you paid for your damaged vehicle, not including any insurance or warranties purchased;
- b. If it is available, the purchase price, as negotiated by us, of a "new vehicle" of the same make, model, and equipment or the most similar model available, not including any furnishings, parts, or equipment not installed by the manufacturer or manufacturers' dealership; or

We will not pay for initiation or set up costs associated with loans or leases

As used in this endorsement, a "new vehicle" means an "auto" of which you are the original owner that has not been previ-

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ously titled and which you purchased less than 365 days before the date of the "loss".

U. PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE EXTENSIONS

Under SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE, A. Coverage, Coverage Extensions, b. Loss of Use Expenses is replaced by the following:

b. Loss of Use Expenses

For Hired Auto Physical Damage, we will pay expenses for which an "insured" becomes legally responsible to pay for loss of use of a vehicle rented or hired without a driver, under a written rental contract or agreement. We will pay for loss of use expenses if caused by:

- (1) Other than collision if the Declarations indicate that Comprehensive Coverage is provided for any covered "auto";
- (2) Specified Causes of Loss only if the Declarations indicate that Specified Causes of Loss Coverage is provided for any covered "auto"; or

Item (5) of the Policy Period, Coverage Territory General Conditions is replaced by the following.

(5) Anywhere in the world if a covered "auto" is leased, hired, rented or borrowed without a driver for a period of 30 days or less, and

Y. EMERGENCY LOCKOUT

We will reimburse you up to \$100 for reasonable expense incurred for the services of a locksmith to gain entry into your covered "auto" subject to these provisions:

1. Your door key, electronic key or key entry pad has been lost, stolen or locked in your covered "auto" and you are unable to enter such "auto", or
2. Your keyless entry device battery dies and you are unable to enter such "auto" as a result,
3. Your key, electronic key or key entry pad has been lost or stolen and you have changed the lock to prevent an unauthorized entry; and

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- 4 Original copies of receipts for services of a locksmith must be provided before reimbursement is payable.

Z. CANCELLATION CONDITION

Paragraph A.2. of the COMMON POLICY CONDITION - CANCELLATION applies except as follows:

If we cancel for any reason other than non-payment of premium, we will mail or deliver to the First Named Insured written notice of cancellation at least 60 days before the effective date of cancellation. This provision does not apply in those states that require more than 60 days prior notice of cancellation.
