



**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

The County of Riverside Continuum of Care (CoC) is designed to assess the need for homeless and affordable housing services throughout the County of Riverside and to serve as the planning body that coordinates the community's policies, strategies, and activities toward ending homelessness.

The CoC charter states that the continuum shall have a Board of Governance (BOG) comprised of elected members who advocate for and provide information and/or recommendations to the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors, local government and other elected officials; and that the BOG shall monitor the overall effectiveness of the CoC planning processes and activities. The charter specifies that the CoC BOG shall be comprised of 17 members, including one (1) seat representing the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors.

This action will establish Supervisor Karen Spiegel as the Board of Supervisors representative to the BOG. Supervisor Spiegel is filling a seat vacated by Supervisor Chuck Washington.
