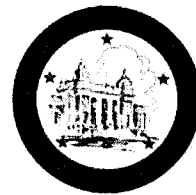

BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Riverside Ending Homelessness Fund will be used to sponsor their 5K Walk to End Homelessness, which raises money to provide individuals and families the items necessary to transition out of homelessness into permanent housing and obtain employment.
2. The donation to Norco Horseweek will be used to sponsor the Norco Horse Week rodeo which provides 10 days of community entertainment. All excess proceeds of the rodeo support several local non-profits.
