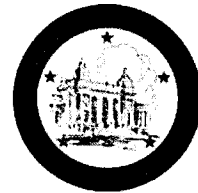





**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Inland Empire Hispanic Leadership Council - \$5,000: Funding will be used to support projects with the Inland Empire Hispanic Leadership Council that enhance civil understanding, provide leadership and financial support throughout their various community leadership series, scholarships and annual summits.
2. Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$10,000: Funding will be used to support programs at the Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce, which offers resources for business owners, programs for military affairs, an annual business expo and the Moreno Valley Student of the Month to provide scholarships for youth.
3. United Way of the Inland Valleys dba Riverside County Employee Campaign - \$5,000: Funding will be used to support the United Way of the Inland Valley dba Riverside County Employee Campaign event that will benefit the Riverside University Health System Medical Center Department of Pediatrics, supporting children's health and bring hope to families.
4. Menifee Valley Historical Association - \$10,000: Funding will be used to support the MVHA's new museum facility. This new facility will continue the organization's goal of promoting awareness of the area's rich heritage. Such programs include Native American history, mining, early settler life, farming, schools and information about those our county's ancestors.
5. Antelope-Menifee Rural Center - \$5,000: Funding will be used to support the necessary upgrading of the facility which has been used by the center since 1972. The Antelope-Menifee Rural Center has been serving the community for over 70 years. This will provide new usable surface space in the community hall, restrooms, and kitchen, which will last for the next 20+ years.
