#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### <u>Summary</u>

This Project will replace the sediment-prone section of underground pipe with an underground reinforced concrete box and three access structures. This conversion will allow maintenance crews to clean the sediment quicker thus reducing the cost of maintenance (see attached project description and location map).

#### **CEQA Findings**

Since the Project only involves replacing an existing storm drain with another storm drain of similar capacity, it is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15302 (c) which exempts "Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity." Based on the project's scope and setting, there are no applicable exceptions to the exemption listed in Section 15300.2 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

Additionally, the District has determined that the project is exempt because it meets the criteria set forth in the "General Rule" Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, which states that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential of causing a significant effect on the environment. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the project may have a significant effect on the environment, therefore, it is not subject to CEQA. Upon Board approval, the Clerk of the Board will file the attached NOE with the County Clerk within five working days of approval by the Board.

The contract documents have been approved as to form by County Counsel. A brief project description and location map is attached.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

This project will replace a portion of an existing underground pipe with an underground reinforced concrete box with three access structures. The replacement will continue to protect the neighborhood from flooding problems and reduce the amount of time to maintain the

sediment prone facility. This project is funded by ad valorem property tax revenue and entails no new fees, taxes or bonded indebtedness.

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

The action on this Form 11 merely approves the Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents identifying the proposed work, as well as authorizes the Clerk of the Board to advertise said contract documents. No expenses will be incurred as a result of this action.

#### **Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

The Engineer's estimate for this Project is \$1,812,000 and the action today, if approved will authorize the District to pursue competitive bids through the California Public Works Contract Process. The District will then return to the Board of Supervisors to seek approval to award the Contract to the lowest responsive bidder.

Project Location - City of Lake Elsinore in Riverside County

The project is located within existing Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) right of way for the Ortega Channel. It is bounded by Highway 74 to the south and Grand Avenue to the east. The project is located within Township 46 South, Range 5 West, Section 11 of the Lake Elsinore USGS 7.5 Series Topographic Quadrangle map. The latitude/longitude for the project is 33° 39' 30.59" N by 117° 22' 40.35" W.

**Project Description and Existing Setting:** A section of the Ortega Channel (an underground reinforced concrete pipe) currently experiences extreme sediment deposition and, due to the design, excavation is very inefficient. The District proposes to replace a 600-foot section of the facility with a reinforced concrete box with three access shafts that can support efficient sediment excavation by allowing three maintenance teams to work concurrently. The project is located in an urban area, on a vacant lot with no sensitive environmental resources.

Public Agency Implementing the Project: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Exempt Status: Class 2 Categorical Exemption [Section 15302(c)] and the General Rule/Common Sense Exemption [Section 15061(b)(3)]

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The project will not result in substantial changes to the capacity, alignment or function of the channel and is consistent with the CEQA Categorical Exemption 15302(c), which exempts "Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity." Based on the project's scope and setting, there are no applicable exceptions to the exemption listed in Section 15300.2 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

Additionally, the District has determined that the project is exempt because it meets the criteria set forth in the "General Rule" Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, which states that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential of causing a significant effect on the environment. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the project may have a significant effect on the environment, therefore, it is not subject to CEQA.

Based upon the exemptions identified above, the District hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.

The awarded prime Contractor shall post job site notices, including a copy of the prevailing rate of per diem wages determinations made by the Director for the Department of Industrial Relations and other notices prescribed by regulations and comply with the provisions of the California Labor Code, including, without limitation, Sections 1771.4, 1773.1, 1773.2, 1774, 1775, 1776, and 1777.5.

Contractor shall furnish the records specified in Labor Code Section 1776, including but limited to the certified payroll records, directly to the Labor Commissioner for the Department of Industrial Relations.

Substitution of securities for any moneys withheld by District shall be permitted as provided for by Section 22300 of the California Public Con-

Contractors submitting proposals for this project shall have an active and in good standing Class "A" Contractor's license from the State of California in order to be considered eligible for the contract award. The license(s) shall remain active and in good standing throughout the entire duration of the project.

With the submittal of the Bid Proposal, the Contractor shall submit for approval by the District documented evidence of satisfaction of all of the Bidder Qualifications listed above. As part of this submittal, Experi-ence Statement shall be completed indicating at a minimum, the name, address, and phone number of the project owner and owner's representative, the location of the project, the amount of material installed, and completion date.
