1. Approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct election services for the April 14, 2020, City of Rancho Mirage General Municipal Mail Ballot Election.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The City of Rancho Mirage has complied with this requirement and has requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct its election. The department has the resources to provide these services. The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Registered voters in the City of Rancho Mirage will have the opportunity to vote for two City Councilmembers.

Additional Fiscal Information

The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election. Approximately \$39,600 of election costs will be reimbursed by the City of Rancho Mirage.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO MIRAGE, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PERMIT THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY OF RANCHO MIRAGE FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2020

WHEREAS, the City of Rancho Mirage (the "City") is a charter city and a political subdivision of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is scheduled to be held in the City, on Tuesday, April 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in the course of conducting the election it is necessary for the City to request certain election services of the Riverside County Registrar of Voters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rancho Mirage will reimburse the County of Riverside for all election services rendered for the City for its General Municipal Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO MIRAGE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals.

That the Recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. Request for Election Services.

That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the California Elections Code, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors permit the Riverside County Registrar of Voters to render election services to the City of Rancho Mirage as may be requested by the City.

Section 3. Reimbursement.

That the City shall reimburse the County of Riverside for election services rendered upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

Section 4. Severability.

That the City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the

remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences or words of this Resolution as hereby adopted shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.

That all the provisions heretofore adopted by the City Council that are in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date.

That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 7. Certification.

That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


Section 8. Certified Copies of Resolution.

That the City Clerk is directed to forward without delay to the Riverside County Board of Supervisors and to the Riverside County Registrar of Voters certified copies of this Resolution.




