

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On September 30, 2014 via Minute Order #3-18 the Board approved personal service agreements with Industrial Wasted Utilization Inc. and Environmental Logistics Inc. for Hazardous Waste Removal Services as a result of an award from a competitive bid. County departments have been using these two contractors to remove various hazardous items and dispose of them in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations.

Purchasing is in the process of rebidding these services but requires an extension through September 29, 2020 with the current vendors to continue providing hazardous waste removal services throughout the County.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

By allowing the services to continue, the removal of such hazardous waste will ensure safe disposal of hazardous materials (e.g. used oil, filters, paint, solvents, etc.) generated by county departments.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The aggregate amount of \$300,000 will be used between the two contractors for the contract extension through September 29, 2020.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

Purchasing released Request for Proposal (RFP) PUARC-1279 in February 2014 and received four (4) responses. The evaluation committee selected Industrial Wasted Utilization Inc. and Environmental Logistics Inc. to be the lowest responsive bidders. Both contractors have diligently performed the hazardous waste removal services throughout the contracts five-year





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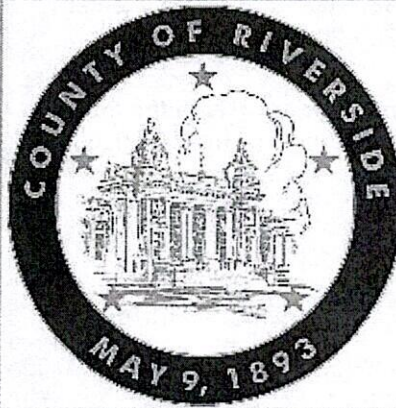
period. The two vendors have agreed to maintain current pricing through the contract extension period.

This Amendment No. 5 to the Personal Service Agreement for Hazardous Waste Removal Services is entered into this day of September 30, 2019, by and between County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (COUNTY) and Industrial Waste Utilization, Inc., a California corporation (CONTRACTOR).

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into the Personal Service Agreement for Hazardous Waste Removal Services, effective September 30, 2014 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR desire to amend the Agreement to modify the period of performance and payment provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Section 2 Period of Performance:** Delete the first sentence in its entirety and replace with the following:  
This Agreement shall be in effect upon signature of this Agreement by both parties and continue in effect through September 29, 2020, unless terminated earlier.
3. **Section 3 Compensation:** Delete the second sentence in its entirety and replace with the following:  
Maximum payments by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) annually, including all expenses.
4. **Exhibit B Payment Provisions** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached **Exhibit B-1**.
5. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged. The provisions of this amendment shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Agreement, as heretofore amended, and shall supplement the remaining provisions thereof.







2. **Section 2 Period of Performance:** Delete the first sentence in its entirety and replace with the following:  
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4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged. The provisions of this amendment shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Agreement, as heretofore amended, and shall supplement the remaining provisions thereof.
