BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Canyon Lake Woman’s Club - \$1000** funding will be used to support their Scholarship Program which will award scholarships to Canyon Lake female residents who are currently in their senior year of high school.
2. **Riverside County Sheriff’s Department - \$500** funding will be used to support their employee and community volunteer recognition ceremony.
3. **Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee - \$2,500** funds will be used to assist with the maintenance and operations of the Riverside National Cemetery.
4. **Big Brothers Big Sister of the Inland Empire - \$1,500** funding will be used to provide support to a free after school program that matches high school students with elementary school students on school campuses in the 1st District to promote academic and social support.
