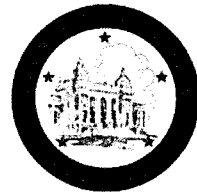



BACKGROUND:

Summary

Mountain Communities Fire Safe Council (MCFSC) is a group of volunteers with the sole purpose of making the communities on the San Jacinto Mountain area safer from a wildland fire. To accomplish this, they help their neighbors remove hazardous fuels from their properties. The MCFSC board recently contacted the County of Riverside to request one surplus vehicle to evaluate potential properties and to remove large fuels by thinning trees, eliminating ladder fuels and more.
