

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The cost of a POW-MIA Flag is \$60.00. A local Veteran has donated that flag for the monument.

**BACKGROUND:**

Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park was dedicated to honor our Veterans on Friday, May 25, 2018. The project was designed by members of the 4th District Veterans Cabinet, 4th District staffers, and local architects. It features flag poles, displaying the flags of each branch of the Armed Forces displayed in accordance with the Department of Defense protocols. Also featured is a flag pole that fly's the flag of the United States of America. Each of the 6 flags is illuminated and fly's around the clock 7 days per week. Adding the POW-MIA flag will complete the monument and honors those listed as missing in Action or as Prisoners of War. The POW-MIA flag will also be flown daily and displayed on the same flag pole as the U.S. flag. Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park is the only park owned and operated by the county that honors our Veterans for their service in the Active Duty, Guard, and Federal and State Reserve Forces.
